SUBJECT: AIA 2011 ANNUAL REPORT – LINCOLN DISTRICT

The Lincoln District Alcohol Impact area was approved on July 16, 2008 with enforcement starting at the end of September 2008.

Compliance checks have run continually since October 1, 2008. TPD Officer Bert Hayes and Community Representative Robert McCutchan have checked “off-premises” licensees for restricted products adopted by the Washington State Liquor Control Board.

The 2011 compliance checks began on January 19th and January 25th. During these inspection dates, all businesses were found to be in compliance. The years second set of inspections started on September 6th of 2011, a total of 18 licensees’s were contacted and checked. These businesses were selected due to prior liquor law violation or heavy activity. During these compliance checks, we found one business that had banned product stored on its premise.

A verbal warning was issued to the clerk and the banned items were removed by September 7th, no citations were issued.

Officer Hayes has been working with the City of Olympia on a proposed Alcohol Impact Area in that city. The City of Tacoma has provided all pertinent documentation for this purpose.

Attached are the reports from the Tacoma Police Department and Tacoma Fire Department statistical analysis departments. These reports show a continuing drop in alcohol related criminal offenses. Tacoma Fire Department calls show a stabilization of calls for service in the Alcohol Impact Area. See individual maps and calls for service for details.

To create a safe and secure environment in which to live, work, and visit by working together with the community, enforcing the law in a fair and impartial manner, preserving the peace and order in our neighborhoods, and safeguarding our constitutional guarantees.




Selected Calls for Service - Lincoln Alcohol Impact Area (AIA)


1 September 2009 to 31 August 2010

Selected Calls for Service - Lincoln Alcohol Impact Area (AIA) 1 September 2010 to 31 August 2011




