



**Bill Title:** Growler Sales of Cider  
**Bill Number:** SSB 6442  
**Effective Date:** June 12, 2014  
Creates a new section in RCW 66.28.

**Summary:**

This bill permits licensees currently allowed to sell beer in growlers to also sell cider in growlers. The licensee must comply with federal laws and regulations.

License types that may apply for an endorsement that allows the sale of cider in growlers:

- Beer/Wine Specialty Shops (apply for the Growlers endorsement).
- Beer/Wine Restaurants (apply for the Off-Premises endorsement).
- Beer/Wine Taverns (apply for the Off-Premises endorsement).
- Spirits/Beer/Wine Restaurants (apply for the Kegs to Go endorsement).

**How to Apply:**

Retail licensees that meet the criteria and want to offer growlers of cider must:

- Complete and submit an Application for Added Endorsement (LIQ 756-50), to the Liquor Control Board Licensing Division. Submit fees if applicable.
- Submit a copy of the federal wine bottling facility permit from TTB.
- Licensing staff will notify the licensee of any required documents needed to process the request.
- Licensing and Regulation Division staff will send a letter to the licensee approving the endorsement.
