<input type="checkbox"/> <b>Caterer</b>	Extends the on-premises license privilege to allow the sale and service of liquor authorized by your license at approved locations other than the licensed premises.	\$ 350
<input type="checkbox"/> <b>Caterer Duplicate</b>	Allows the holder of a Spirits, Beer, Wine Restaurant license or a beer and/or wine restaurant license with a caterer's endorsement, under conditions established by the board, to store liquor on other premises operated by the licensee so long as the other premises are owned or controlled by a leasehold interest by that licensee.	\$ 20
<input type="checkbox"/> <b>Non-Club Event</b>	Allows use of club liquor at up to 40 non-club member-sponsored events annually. (For private clubs & restaurants not serving the general public).	\$ 900
<input type="checkbox"/> <b>Off-Premises</b>	Allows sale of beer and /or wine for off-premises consumption in original, unopened containers. (Tap beer may also be sold for off-premises consumption in kegs not less than four gallons and in other sanitary containers.)	\$ 120

<input type="checkbox"/>	<b>Off-Premises Sale Private Label Wine</b>	Allows the holder of a spirits, beer & wine restaurant, spirits, beer and wine club, beer and wine club or sports/entertainment license to sell privately labeled wine by the unopened bottle for off-premises consumption.	\$ 120
<input type="checkbox"/>	<b>Sale at Farmers Market</b>	Allows a domestic brewery that qualifies for the federal reduced tax rate, a domestic winery, or a microbrewery to sell bottled beer or wine at qualified farmers markets.	\$ 75
<input type="checkbox"/>	<b>Certificate of Approval Shipping directly to Washington Retailers</b>	Allows a U.S. winery or brewery that holds a Certificate of Approval with Washington to ship beer and wine of their own production directly to a licensed retailer approved to receive shipments.  The U.S. winery/brewery must be licensed by the state they are located in and the TTB.	\$ 100
<input type="checkbox"/>	<b>Washington Retailer Receiving Direct Shipments</b>	Allows a licensed Washington retailer to receive shipments of beer and wine from a U.S. winery or brewery holding a Certificate of Approval to ship into Washington, or a domestic winery, brewery or micro brewery.	No Fee
<input type="checkbox"/>	<b>Certificate of Approval Shipping to Washington Consumers</b>	Allows a U.S. winery holding a Certificate of Approval to ship wine of their own production to Washington consumers. The U.S. winery must be licensed by the state they are located in as a winery and by the TTB.	No Fee
<input type="checkbox"/>	<b>Kegs to Go</b>	Allows the holder of a Spirits, Beer and Wine Restaurant license to sell for off-premises consumption malt liquor in kegs or other containers that are capable of holding four or more gallons of liquid.	\$120
<input type="checkbox"/>	<b>Alcohol in Candy</b>	Allows a Grocery Store licensee holding a Snack Bar license to sell confections containing more than one percent but not more than ten percent alcohol by weight to persons twenty-one years of age.	No Fee
