

WAC 197-11-970 Determination of nonsignificance (DNS).

DETERMINATION OF NONSIGNIFICANCE

Description of proposal:

This proposal is a rule establishing a system to license and regulate marijuana production, distribution, and possession for persons 21 years of age or older imposed by the passage of Initiative 502. I-502 requires a tightly controlled and regulated marijuana market including strict controls to prevent diversion, illegal sales, and sales to minors while providing reasonable access to products to mitigate the illicit market. The requirements in the proposal are designed to comply with the initiative's mandate.

Proponent:

Washington State Liquor Control Board

Location of proposal, including street address, if any:

The rules are statewide and apply to anyone wanting to produce, process or sell at retail recreational marijuana.

Lead agency:

Washington State Liquor Control Board

The lead agency for this proposal has determined that it does not have a probable significant adverse impact on the environment.
