December 21, 2011	Liquor Control Board sets new tentative timeline for adopting or rejecting the City of Seattle's request for extended hours of alcohol service
March 5 – May 7, 2012	Liquor Control Board schedules and leads public hearings around the state on the concept proposed by the City of Seattle <ol style="list-style-type: none">1. Seattle2. Bellingham3. Everett4. Tacoma5. Olympia6. Vancouver7. Tri-Cities8. Yakima9. Spokane
May 7, 2012	End of written comment period
May 16, 2012	Board is asked whether to prepare rules or reject rules
May 16, 2012	If Board rejects, staff notifies City of Seattle that its petition is denied
May 16, 2012	If Board approves, staff files a CR 102 with proposed rules and moves forward on typical rule-making timeline
September 19, 2012	New rules are effective
