14 The Washington State Liquor Control Board Education and Enforcement Division
15 ("Enforcement") represented by its attorneys ROB MCKENNA, Attorney General and
16 JENNIFER ELIAS, Assistant Attorney General and the Permit Holder, LEAH BICKERTON
17 ("Permit Holder"), of Spokane, Washington, hereby enter into this stipulated settlement
18 agreement for case number 22,387.

19 **I. INTRODUCTION**

20 The Washington State Liquor Control Board charged the above-named Permit Holder
21 in its complaint dated June 14, 2006, with the following violation of the Washington State
22 Liquor Act:

23 On or about December 14, 2005, the above-named Permit Holder, allowed or
24 engaged in behavior that provokes conduct which presents a threat to public
safety in violation of WAC 314-11-015(3)(c).

25 Enforcement and the Permit Holder wish to enter into a settlement agreement
26 concerning the above-referenced complaint.

II. AGREEMENT OF THE PARTIES

Enforcement and the Permit Holder agree to the following:

1. Enforcement and the Permit Holder enter into this agreement to avoid the time and expense of further litigation. The Permit Holder explicitly waives the right of further administrative review of all matters related to this violation. The Permit Holder hereby voluntarily withdraws her request for a hearing on the matter.

2. The Permit Holder admits to the above-referenced complaint. On December 14, 2005, the Permit Holder allowed or engaged in behavior that provoked conduct which presented a threat to public safety.

3. As a first violation for allowing disorderly conduct, the parties agree that the penalty for the above violation shall be a fifty-dollar (\$50.00) civil monetary penalty, to be paid within 30 days of the date of the Final Order of the Board.

4. The parties recognize that this settlement agreement is subject to approval by the WASHINGTON STATE LIQUOR CONTROL BOARD.



