The Washington State Liquor Control Board Education and Enforcement Division ("Enforcement") represented by its attorneys ROB MCKENNA, Attorney General and JENNIFER ELIAS, Assistant Attorney General and the Licensee, PRIYANA, INC., D/B/A VALLEY 76 ("Licensee"), of Mill Creek, Washington, represented by DAN CLAWSON, Attorney at Law, hereby enter into this stipulated settlement agreement for case number 22,426.

I. INTRODUCTION

The Washington State Liquor Control Board charged the above-named Licensee in its complaint dated June 10, 2006, with the following violation of the Washington State Liquor Act:

On or about March 24, 2006, the above-named Licensee, or an employee thereof, gave, sold and/or supplied liquor to a person under the age of twenty-one (21), in violation of RCW 66.44.270 and WAC 314-11-020.

1 Enforcement and the Licensee wish to enter into a settlement agreement concerning the
2 above-referenced complaint.

3 II. AGREEMENT OF THE PARTIES

4 Enforcement and the Licensee agree to the following:

5 1. Enforcement and the Licensee enter into this agreement to avoid the time and
6 expense of further litigation. The Licensee explicitly waives the right of further administrative
7 review of all matters related to this violation. The Licensee hereby voluntarily withdraws its
8 request for a hearing on the matter.

9 2. The Licensee admits to the above-referenced complaint. On March 24, 2006,
10 an employee of the Licensee sold alcohol to a person under 21 years of age.

11 3. As a first violation for sale of alcohol to a minor within the last two years, the
12 parties agree that the penalty for the above violation shall be a 4-day suspension of the
13 Licensee's liquor license or a monetary fine of \$400.00, to be paid or served within 30 days of
14 the date of the Final Order of the Board.

15 4. The parties recognize that this settlement agreement is subject to approval by
16 the WASHINGTON STATE LIQUOR CONTROL BOARD.


