STIPULATED SETTLEMENT  
AGREEMENT AND PROPOSED  
ORDER

The Washington State Liquor Control Board Education and Enforcement Division ("Enforcement") represented by its attorneys ROBERT M. MCKENNA, Attorney General and RUTH AMMONS, Assistant Attorney General and the Licensee, VOLCANO VENTURES LLC, d/b/a LAKESIDE RV BAR & GRILL ("Licensee"), of Silver Lake, Washington, represented by STEVE GIBLER, hereby enter into this stipulated settlement agreement for case number 22,427.

**I. INTRODUCTION**

The Washington State Liquor Control Board charged the above-named Licensee in its complaint dated June 30, 2006, with the following violations of the Washington State Liquor Act:

That on or about and between November 19, 2005 and November 20, 2005, the Licensee was apparently intoxicated on the licensed premises in violation of WAC 314-11-015(3)(a) and/or was consuming liquor while working on the licensed premises, in violation of

1 WAC 314-11-015(3)(d);

2 That on or about and between November 19, 2005 and November 20, 2005, the  
3 Licensee did engage in or allow behavior that provoked conduct which presented a threat to  
4 public safety, in violation of WAC 314-11-015(3)(c); and,

5 That on or about and between November 19, 2005 and November 20, 2005, the  
6 Licensee, or employee(s) thereof, did supply liquor to a person apparently under the influence  
7 of liquor, or did allow an apparently intoxicated person to possess or consume liquor on the  
8 licensed premises, in violation of WAC 314-11-035.

## 9 II. AGREEMENT OF THE PARTIES

10 Prior to a hearing in this matter, Enforcement and the Licensee have agreed to enter  
11 into the following settlement concerning the above-referenced Complaint. Enforcement and  
12 the Licensee agree to the following:

13 1. Enforcement and the Licensee enter into this agreement to avoid the time and  
14 expense of further litigation.

15 2. The Licensee explicitly waives the right of further administrative review of all  
16 matters related to the above-referenced Complaint. Furthermore, the Licensee hereby  
17 voluntarily withdraws his request for a hearing on this matter.

18 3. This Agreement constitutes the final written expression of all the terms of this  
19 Agreement and is a complete and exclusive statement of these terms.

20 4. The Licensee, STEVE GIBLER, admits to the following violations set forth in  
21 the above-referenced Complaint:

22 On or about and between November 19, 2005 and November 20, 2005, the Licensee  
23 was apparently intoxicated on the licensed premises; and,

24 On or about and between November 19, 2005 and November 20, 2005, the Licensee  
25 engaged in or allowed behavior that provoked conduct which presented a threat to public  
26 safety.

1 5. Enforcement agrees to withdraw and dismiss the remaining violations set forth  
2 in the above-referenced Complaint.

3 6. The parties agree that the penalty for the above violation shall be 10 days  
4 suspension, effective: 10 AM on Monday, April 16, 2007, to 10 AM on Thursday, April 26,  
5 2007.

6 7. The parties recognize that this settlement agreement is subject to approval by  
7 the WASHINGTON STATE LIQUOR CONTROL BOARD.


