STIPULATED SETTLEMENT
AGREEMENT AND PROPOSED
ORDER

The Washington State Liquor Control Board Education and Enforcement Division ("Enforcement") represented by its attorneys ROBERT M. MCKENNA, Attorney General and JENNIFER ELIAS, Assistant Attorney General and the Licensee, T.A. RESTAURANT, INC., d/b/a EAGLE HARBOR PUB AND GRILL ("Licensee"), of Bainbridge Island, Washington, represented by its corporate officer, TOM AYDELOTTE, hereby enter into this stipulated settlement agreement for case number 22,717.

I. INTRODUCTION

The Washington State Liquor Control Board charged the above-named Licensee in its complaint dated January 31, 2007, with the following violation of the Washington State Liquor Act:

On or about November 1, 2006, the above-named Licensee, or an employee thereof, gave, sold and/or supplied liquor to a person under the age of twenty-one (21), in violation of RCW 66.44.270 and WAC 314-11-020 and allowed a person under the age of twenty-one (21) to frequent a restricted area, in violation of RCW 66.44.310(1)(a).

1 Enforcement and the Licensee wish to enter into a settlement agreement concerning the above-
2 referenced complaint.

3 **II. AGREEMENT OF THE PARTIES**

4 Enforcement and the Licensee agree to the following:

5 1. Enforcement and the Licensee enter into this agreement to avoid the time and
6 expense of further litigation. The Licensee explicitly waives the right of further administrative
7 review of all matters related to this violation. The Licensee hereby voluntarily withdraws its
8 request for a hearing on the matter.

9 2. The Licensee admits to the above-referenced complaint. On November 1, 2006,
10 an employee of the Licensee sold alcohol to a person under 21 years of age and allowed a
11 minor to frequent a restricted area.


12 3. As a first violation for sale of alcohol to a minor, the parties agree that the
13 penalty for the above violation shall be a 3-day suspension of the Licensee's liquor license or a
14 monetary fine of \$300.00, to be paid or served within 30 days of the date of the Final Order of
15 the Board. The Licensee also agrees that he will view and make available to his employees,
16 the Board's instructional video, "Responsible Liquor Sales". In addition, the Licensee has also
17 expressed a willingness to cooperate with local law enforcement.

18 4. The parties recognize that this settlement agreement is subject to approval by
19 the WASHINGTON STATE LIQUOR CONTROL BOARD.


