STIPULATED SETTLEMENT
AGREEMENT AND PROPOSED
ORDER

The Washington State Liquor Control Board Education and Enforcement Division ("Enforcement") represented by its attorneys ROBERT M. MCKENNA, Attorney General and RUTH AMMONS, Assistant Attorney General and the Licensee, JAMES GANG INC., d/b/a JAMES GANG TAVERN ("Licensee"), of Union Gap, Washington, represented by Pat Jefferies, hereby enter into this stipulated settlement agreement for case number 22,718.

I. INTRODUCTION

The Washington State Liquor Control Board charged the above-named Licensee in its Complaint dated March 5, 2007, with the following violations of the Washington State Liquor Act:

On or about December 1, 2006, the Licensee, or an employee thereof, did allow an apparently intoxicated person to possess and/or consume liquor on the licensed premises, contrary to RCW 66.44.200(2) and WAC 314-16-150(2); and

1 On or about December 1, 2006, the Licensee, or an employee thereof, consumed liquor
2 while working on the licensed premises, contrary to WAC 314-11-015(3)(d).

3 **II. AGREEMENT OF THE PARTIES**

4 Prior to a hearing in this matter, Enforcement and the Licensee have agreed to enter
5 into the following settlement concerning the above-referenced Complaint. Enforcement and
6 the Licensee agree to the following:

7 1. Enforcement and the Licensee enter into this agreement to avoid the time and
8 expense of further litigation.

9 2. The Licensee explicitly waives the right of further administrative review of all
10 matters related to the above-referenced Complaint. Furthermore, the Licensee hereby
11 voluntarily withdraws his request for a hearing on this matter.

12 3. This Agreement constitutes the final written expression of all the terms of this
13 Agreement and is a complete and exclusive statement of these terms.

14 4. The Licensee, PAT JEFFERIES, admits to the violations set forth in the above-
15 referenced Complaint. On December 1, 2006, an employee of the Licensee allowed an
16 apparently intoxicated person to possess and/or consume liquor on the licensed premises.
17 Additionally, on December 1, 2006, an employee of the Licensee consumed liquor while
18 working on the licensed premises.

19 5. The parties agree that the penalty for the above violations shall be a monetary
20 fine of \$300.00, to be paid within 30 days of the date of the Final Order of the Board.

21 6. The parties recognize that this settlement agreement is subject to approval by
22 the WASHINGTON STATE LIQUOR CONTROL BOARD.
