STIPULATED SETTLEMENT
AGREEMENT AND PROPOSED
ORDER

The Washington State Liquor Control Board Education and Enforcement Division ("Enforcement") represented by its attorneys ROBERT M. MCKENNA, Attorney General and JENNIFER ELIAS, Assistant Attorney General and the Licensee, Big Al's Inc., d/b/a Big Al's ("Licensee"), represented by DAVID H. SMITH, Attorney at Law, hereby enter into this stipulated settlement agreement for case number 22,721.

I. INTRODUCTION

The Washington State Liquor Control Board charged the above-named Licensee in its complaint dated March 20, 2007, with the following violation of the Washington State Liquor Act:

On or about October 7, 2006, the above-named Licensee, or an employee thereof, allowed a person under 21 (twenty-one) years of age to frequent a restricted premises contrary to RCW 66.44.310.

1 Enforcement and the Licensee wish to enter into a settlement agreement concerning the
2 above-referenced complaint.

3 **II. AGREEMENT OF THE PARTIES**

4 Enforcement and the Licensee agree to the following:


5 1. Enforcement and the Licensee enter into this agreement to avoid the time and
6 expense of further litigation. The Licensee explicitly waives the right of further administrative
7 review of all matters related to this violation. The Licensee hereby voluntarily withdraws its
8 request for a hearing on the matter.


9 2. The parties agree that the above complaint will be converted into a written
10 warning based on changes made to the restricted area of the licensed premises on October 18,
11 2006, and the Licensee's clear administrative record since the incident of October 7, 2006.

12 4. The parties recognize that this settlement agreement is subject to approval by
13 the WASHINGTON STATE LIQUOR CONTROL BOARD.




III. ORDER


1 IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the above-referenced complaint shall be converted
