STIPULATED SETTLEMENT
AGREEMENT AND [PROPOSED]
ORDER

The Washington State Liquor Control Board Education and Enforcement Division (“Enforcement”) represented by its attorneys ROBERT M. MCKENNA, Attorney General and KATE REYNOLDS, Assistant Attorney General and the Licensee, Robert Racicot, owner of The Shed Inc. d/b/a Broadway Bar & Grill (“Licensee”), hereby enter into this stipulated settlement agreement for LCB Case Number 22,727.

I. INTRODUCTION

The Washington State Liquor Control Board charged the above-named Licensee in its complaint dated March 20, 2007, with the following violation of the Washington State Liquor Act:

On or about December 1, 2006, the above named licensee, or an employee(s) thereof, did sell, give, or otherwise supply liquor to a person under the age of 21 years, contrary to RCW 66.44.270 and WAC 314-16-150.

ORIGINAL

1 Enforcement and the Licensee wish to enter into a settlement agreement concerning the
2 above-referenced complaint.

3 **II. AGREEMENT OF THE PARTIES**

4 Enforcement and the Licensee agree to the following:

5 1. Enforcement and the Licensee enter into this agreement to avoid the time and
6 expense of further litigation. The Licensee explicitly waives the right of further administrative
7 review of all matters related to this violation. The Licensee hereby voluntarily withdraws its
8 request for a hearing on the matter.

9 2. The Licensee admits to the above-referenced complaint. On December 1, 2006,
10 the Licensee or an employee of the Licensee sold alcohol to a person under 21 years of age.

11 3. The Licensee agrees to pay a monetary penalty of two thousand five hundred
12 dollars (\$2,500); this amount shall be paid within thirty (30) days of the date of the final order
13 of the Washington State Liquor Control Board. Payment shall be made to the Washington
14 State Liquor Control Board no later than 4:00 p.m. on the applicable date. In the event that the
15 Licensee does not make a timely payment, then and in that event, the Licensee shall serve a
16 five (5) day suspension of its liquor license, the dates and time of which shall be set by the
17 Washington State Liquor Control Board.

18 4. The parties recognize that this settlement agreement is subject to approval by
19 the Washington State Liquor Control Board.
