23 2006-LCB-0080, dated August 27, 2007;


24 and the Board having adopted in their entirety the Order of Default, OAH Docket No. 2006-

1 IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the Complaint filed in Liquor Control Board Case No.
2 22,729 is sustained and the Licensee shall serve a thirty (30) day suspension of its liquor
3 license, beginning five days after entry of this Final Order, from October 3, 2007,
4 through November 2, 2007.

15 Reconsideration. Pursuant to RCW 34.05.470, you have ten (10) days from the mailing of this
16 Order to file a petition for reconsideration stating the specific grounds on which relief is
17 requested. No matter will be reconsidered unless it clearly appears from the petition for
18 reconsideration that (a) there is material clerical error in the order or (b) there is specific material
19 error of fact or law. A petition for reconsideration, together with any argument in support thereof,
20 should be filed by mailing or delivering it directly to the Washington State Liquor Control Board,
21 Attention: Kevin McCarroll, 3000 Pacific Avenue Southeast, PO Box 43076, Olympia, WA
22 98504-3076, with a copy to all other parties of record and their representatives. Filing means
23 actual receipt of the document at the Board's Office. RCW 34.05.010(6). A copy shall also be
24 sent to Martha P. Lantz, Assistant Attorney General, 1125 Washington Street SE, PO Box 40110,
25
26 Olympia, WA 98504-0110. A timely petition for reconsideration is deemed to be denied if,

1 within twenty (20) days from the date the petition is filed, the agency does not (a) dispose of the
2 petition or (b) serve the parties with a written notice specifying the date by which it will act on the
3 petition. An order denying reconsideration is not subject to judicial review. RCW 34.05.470(5).
4 The filing of a petition for reconsideration is not a prerequisite for filing a petition for judicial
5 review.

6 Stay of Effectiveness. The filing of a petition for reconsideration does not stay the
7 effectiveness of this Order. The Board has determined not to consider a petition to stay the
8 effectiveness of this Order. Any such request should be made in connection with a petition for
9 judicial review under chapter 34.05 RCW and RCW 34.05.550.
10

11 Judicial Review. Proceedings for judicial review may be instituted by filing a petition in
12 superior court according to the procedures specified in chapter 34.05 RCW, Part V, Judicial
13 Review and Civil Enforcement. The petition for judicial review of this Order shall be filed with
14 the appropriate court and served on the Board, the Office of the Attorney General, and all parties
15 within thirty days after service of the final order, as provided in RCW 34.05.542.
16

17 Service. This Order was served on you the day it was deposited in the United States mail.
