
THIS MATTER having come before the Washington State Liquor Control Board (Board) and the Washington State Liquor Control Board Education and Enforcement Division having been represented by its attorneys, ROBERT M. MCKENNA, Attorney General and RUTH AMMONS, Assistant Attorney General and Frank and Cheri Schnarrs, owners of FRANKIE'S SPORTS BAR & GRILL (Licensees), having been represented by JACK W. HANEMANN, and the parties having voluntarily entered into a stipulated settlement agreement for case number 22,744, and the Board having considered the stipulated settlement agreement and the file materials maintained in this case, now therefore

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the Complaint filed in Liquor Control Board Case No. 22,744 is sustained and the Licensees shall pay a monetary penalty of \$3,000.00 to: Washington State Liquor Control Board, P.O. Box 43095, Olympia, WA 98504-3095. The Licensees shall pay the monetary penalty in three (3) separate payments of one thousand dollars (\$1,000.00) each.


1 The first payment of one thousand dollars (\$1,000.00) shall be made no later than 30 days  
2 after the date of the Final Order of the Board. The second payment of one thousand dollars  
3 (\$1,000.00) shall be made no later than 60 days after the date of the Final Order of the Board.  
4 The third and final payment of one thousand dollars (\$1,000.00) shall be made no later than 90  
5 days after the date of the Final Order of the Board. In the event that the Licensees do not make  
6 a full and timely payment of the monetary penalty, then the Licensees shall serve a three (3)  
7 day suspension of their liquor license, the dates and time of which shall be set by the  
8 Washington State Liquor Control Board.

STIPULATED SETTLEMENT  
AGREEMENT

The Washington State Liquor Control Board Education and Enforcement Division (Enforcement), by and through its attorneys, ROBERT M. MCKENNA, Attorney General and RUTH AMMONS, Assistant Attorney General and Frank and Cheri Schnarrs, owners of FRANKIE'S SPORTS BAR GILL (Licensees), of Olympia, Washington, by and through their attorney, JACK W. HANEMANN, hereby enter into this stipulated settlement agreement for case number 22,744.

**I. INTRODUCTION**

The Washington State Liquor Control Board charged the above-named Licensees in its Complaint dated June 12, 2007, with the following violation of the Washington State Liquor Act and/or Revised Rules and Regulations of the Board:

On or about March 8, 2007, the above named Licensees, or an employee(s) thereof, sold, gave, and/or otherwise supplied liquor to a person under the age of 21 years, in violation of RCW 66.44.270(1).

1 **II. AGREEMENT OF THE PARTIES**

2 Prior to a hearing in this matter, Enforcement and the Licensees have agreed to enter  
3 into the following settlement concerning the above-referenced Complaint. Enforcement and  
4 the Licensees agree to the following:

5 1. Enforcement and the Licensees enter into this agreement to avoid the time and  
6 expense of further litigation.

7 2. The Licensees explicitly waive the right of further administrative review of all  
8 matters related to the above-referenced Complaint. Furthermore, the Licensees hereby  
9 voluntarily withdraw their request for a hearing on this matter.

10 3. This Agreement constitutes the final written expression of all the terms of this  
11 Agreement and is a complete and exclusive statement of these terms.

12 4. The Licensees admit to the violation set forth in the above-referenced  
13 Complaint. On or about March 8, 2007, the above named Licensees, or an employee(s)  
14 thereof, sold, gave and/or otherwise supplied liquor to a person under the age of 21.

15 5. The Licensees agree to pay a monetary penalty of three thousand dollars  
16 (\$3,000.00). The Licensees shall pay the monetary penalty in three (3) separate payments of  
17 one thousand dollars (\$1,000.00) each. The first payment of one thousand dollars (\$1,000.00)  
18 shall be made no later than 30 days after the date of the Final Order of the Board. The second  
19 payment of one thousand dollars (\$1,000.00) shall be made no later than 60 days after the date  
20 of the Final Order of the Board. The third and final payment of one thousand dollars  
21 (\$1,000.00) shall be made no later than 90 days after the date of the Final Order of the Board.

25 6. In the event that the Licensees do not make full and timely payment of the  
26 monetary penalty as required in Section II, Paragraph 5, then the Licensees shall serve a three

1 (3) day suspension of their liquor license, the dates and time of which shall be set by the  
2 Washington State Liquor Control Board.


3 7. The Licensees agree to dismiss with prejudice the Petition for Judicial Review  
4 filed in the Thurston County Superior Court under cause number 07-2-00623-8, relating to  
5 Liquor Control Board Case No. 22,419. A Motion and Order of Dismissal shall be filed with  
6 the Court in that cause no later than 30 days after the date of the Final Order of the Board.

7 8. The parties recognize that this settlement agreement is subject to approval by  
8 the WASHINGTON STATE LIQUOR CONTROL BOARD.


