In the event the Permit Holder fails to make full and timely payment of the monetary penalty, the Permit Holder shall serve a


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1 five (5) day suspension of her permit, the dates and time of which shall be set by the

STIPULATED SETTLEMENT  
AGREEMENT

The Washington State Liquor Control Board Education and Enforcement Division (“Enforcement”) represented by its attorneys ROBERT M. MCKENNA, Attorney General, and KATE REYNOLDS, Assistant Attorney General, and the permit holder, Veronica Levine (“Permit Holder”), hereby enter into this stipulated settlement agreement for LCB Case Number 22,746.

**I. INTRODUCTION**

The Washington State Liquor Control Board charged the above-named permit holder in its complaint dated May 12, 2007, with the following violation of the Washington State Liquor Act:

On or about January 5, 2007, the above-named permit holder permitted one or more persons who were apparently under the influence of liquor to physically possess liquor on the licensed premise in violation of WAC 314-16-150.

Enforcement and the Permit Holder wish to enter into a settlement agreement concerning the above-referenced complaint.

1 **II. AGREEMENT OF THE PARTIES**

2 Enforcement and the Permit Holder agree to the following:

3 1. Enforcement and the Permit Holder enter into this agreement to avoid the time  
4 and expense of further litigation. The Permit Holder explicitly waives the right of further  
5 administrative review of all matters related to this violation. The Permit Holder hereby  
6 voluntarily withdraws her request for a hearing on the matter.

7 2. The Permit Holder admits to the above-referenced complaint. On January 5,  
8 2007, the Permit Holder permitted one or more persons who were apparently under the  
9 influence of liquor to physically possess liquor on the licensed premise.

10 3. The Permit Holder agrees to pay a monetary penalty of fifty dollars (\$50); this  
11 amount shall be paid within thirty (30) days of the date of the final order of the Washington  
12 State Liquor Control Board. Payment shall be made to the Washington State Liquor Control  
13 Board no later than 4:00 p.m. on the applicable date. Payment shall be sent to:

17 4. In the event that the Permit Holder does not make a timely payment, then and in  
18 that event, the Permit Holder shall serve a five (5) day suspension of her permit, the dates and  
19 time of which shall be set by the Washington State Liquor Control Board.

20 5. The parties recognize that this settlement agreement is subject to approval by  
21 the Washington State Liquor Control Board.
