

The Washington State Liquor Control Board Education and Enforcement Division (“Enforcement”), by and through its attorneys, ROBERT M. MCKENNA, Attorney General and RUTH AMMONS, Assistant Attorney General and Scott McKinney and Musong Kim, the owners of PINTS & QUARTS, INC. d/b/a PINTS & QUARTS ALE HOUSE (“Licensees”), of Lacey, Washington, by and through their attorney, CHRISTOPHER COKER, hereby enter into this stipulated settlement agreement for case number 22,750.

I. INTRODUCTION

The Washington State Liquor Control Board charged the above-named Licensees in its Complaint dated June 12, 2007, with the following violations of the Washington State Liquor Act and/or Revised Rules and Regulations of the Board:

On or about March 15, 2007, the above-named Licensees, or employee(s) thereof, engaged in or allowed behavior that provoked conduct which presented a threat to public safety, in violation of WAC 314-11-015(3)(c); and,

1 On or about March 17, 2007, the above-named Licensees, or employee(s) thereof,
2 engaged in or allowed behavior that provoked conduct which presented a threat to public
3 safety, in violation of WAC 314-11-015(3)(c).

4 II. AGREEMENT OF THE PARTIES

5 Prior to a hearing in this matter, Enforcement and the Licensees have agreed to enter
6 into the following settlement concerning the above-referenced Complaint. Enforcement and
7 the Licensees agree to the following:

8 1. Enforcement and the Licensees enter into this agreement to avoid the time and
9 expense of further litigation.

10 2. The Licensees explicitly waive the right of further administrative review of all
11 matters related to the above-referenced Complaint. Furthermore, the Licensees hereby
12 voluntarily withdraw their request for a hearing on this matter.

13 3. This Agreement constitutes the final written expression of all the terms of this
14 Agreement and is a complete and exclusive statement of these terms.

15 4. The Licensees admit to the violations set forth in the above-referenced
16 Complaint. On or about March 15, 2007, and March 17, 2007, the above-named Licensees or
17 their employees engaged in or allowed behavior, to-wit: overcrowding of the premises, that
18 provoked conduct which presented a threat to public safety.

19 5. The Licensees agree to pay a monetary penalty of five hundred dollars
20 (\$500.00) within 30 days of the date of the Final Order of the Board. Payment shall be sent to:

23 6. In the event that the Licensees do not make a full and timely payment of the
24 monetary penalty as required in Section II, Paragraph 5, then the Licensees shall serve a five
25 (5) day suspension of their liquor license, the dates and time of which shall be set by the
26 Washington State Liquor Control Board.


1 7. The parties recognize that this settlement agreement is subject to approval by
