

9 The Washington State Liquor Control Board Education and Enforcement Division
10 (“Enforcement”) represented by its attorneys ROBERT M. MCKENNA, Attorney General and
11 KATE REYNOLDS, Assistant Attorney General and the Licensee, Jeong Yoon, owner of
12 Evergreen Food Store (“Licensee”), represented by Matthew T. Russell of Russell & Hill PLLC,
13 hereby enter into this stipulated settlement agreement for LCB Case Number 22,752.

14 **I. INTRODUCTION**

15 The Washington State Liquor Control Board Education and Enforcement Division
16 issued an Administrative Violation Notice No. 3G7087B (“AVN”) on April 2, 2007, to the
17 above-named Licensee with the following violations of the Washington State Liquor Act:

18 On March 28, 2007, the above named Licensee sold liquor to an apparently intoxicated
19 person contrary to RCW 66.44.200(1).

20 Enforcement and the Licensee wish to enter into a settlement agreement concerning the
21 above-referenced AVN.

22 **II. AGREEMENT OF THE PARTIES**

23 Enforcement and the Licensee agree to the following:

24 1. Enforcement and the Licensee enter into this agreement to avoid the time and
25 expense of further litigation. The Licensee explicitly waives the right of further administrative
26

1 review of all matters related to this violation. The Licensee hereby voluntarily withdraws its
2 request for a hearing on the matter.

3 2. The Licensee admits to the violations in the above-referenced AVN. On
4 March 28, 2007, the above named Licensee sold liquor to an apparently intoxicated person
5 contrary to RCW 66.44.200(1).

6 3. The Licensee agrees to pay a monetary penalty of three hundred dollars (\$300);
7 this amount shall be paid within thirty (30) days of the date of the final order of the
8 Washington State Liquor Control Board. Payment shall be made to the Washington State
9 Liquor Control Board no later than 4:00 p.m. on the applicable date. In the event that the
10 Licensee does not make a timely payment, then and in that event, the Licensee shall serve a
11 five (5) day suspension of its liquor license, the dates and time of which shall be set by the
12 Washington State Liquor Control Board.

13 4. The parties recognize that this settlement agreement is subject to approval by
14 the Washington State Liquor Control Board.


