The Washington State Liquor Control Board Education and Enforcement Division ("Enforcement") represented by its attorneys ROBERT M. MCKENNA, Attorney General, and JENNIFER ELIAS, Assistant Attorney General, and the Licensee, LADY LUCK, INC., d/b/a MAGGIE O'TOOLE'S PUB AND GRUB ("Licensee"), of Lakewood, Washington, represented by its owner, Jeff Corbin, hereby enter into this stipulated settlement agreement for case number 22,756.

**I. INTRODUCTION**

The Washington State Liquor Control Board charged the above-named Licensee in its complaint dated June 28, 2007, with the following violation of the Washington State Liquor Act:

On or about May 10, 2007, the above-named Licensee, or an employee(s) thereof, gave, sold and/or supplied liquor to a person under the age of twenty-one (21) years, in violation of RCW 66.44.270 and WAC 314-11-020(1).

1 Enforcement and the Licensee wish to enter into a settlement agreement concerning the above-  
2 referenced complaint.

3 **II. AGREEMENT OF THE PARTIES**

4 Enforcement and the Licensee agree to the following:

5 1. Enforcement and the Licensee enter into this agreement to avoid the time and  
6 expense of further litigation. The Licensee explicitly waives the right of further administrative  
7 review of all matters related to this violation. The Licensee hereby voluntarily withdraws its  
8 request for a hearing on the matter.

9 2. The Licensee admits to the above-referenced complaint. On May 10, 2007, an  
10 employee of the Licensee sold alcohol to a person under 21 years of age in violation of  
11 RCW 66.44.270 and WAC 314-11-020(1).

12 3. As a second violation for sale of alcohol to a minor, the parties agree that the  
13 penalty for the above violation shall be a 3-day suspension of the Licensee's liquor license and  
14 a monetary fine of \$500.00. The suspension shall occur on dates set by the Board in its Final  
15 Order. The \$500.00 fine shall be paid within 30 days of the date of the Final Order of the  
16 Board. Payment shall be made to the Washington State Liquor Control Board in such a  
17 manner that the payment is received by the Washington State Liquor Control Board no later  
18 than 4:00 p.m. on the applicable date. In the event that the Licensee does not make a timely  
19 payment, then and in that event, the Licensee shall serve an additional five (5) day suspension  
20 of its liquor license, the dates and time of which shall be set by the Washington State Liquor  
21 Control Board.




