
MAST PERMIT NO. 120173384

The Washington State Liquor Control Board Education and Enforcement Division (“Enforcement”) represented by its attorneys ROBERT M. MCKENNA, Attorney General and GORDON KARG, Assistant Attorney General and the MAST Permit Holder, ERIC L. NOVICH (“Permit Holder”), hereby enter into this stipulated settlement agreement for Liquor Control Board Case Number 22,759.

**I. INTRODUCTION**

The Washington State Liquor Control Board charged the above-named Permit Holder in its Complaint dated December 18, 2007, with the following violation of the Washington State Liquor Act:

1. That on or about April 13, 2007 the above-named Permit Holder, allowed or permitted an apparently intoxicated person(s) to consume and/or possess alcohol on a licensed premises, contrary to WAC 314-16-150.




1           4.     The parties recognize that this settlement agreement is subject to approval by
