


STIPULATED SETTLEMENT
AGREEMENT

9 The Washington State Liquor Control Board Education and Enforcement Division
10 ("Enforcement") represented by its attorneys ROBERT M. MCKENNA, Attorney General and
11 KATE REYNOLDS, Assistant Attorney General and the Licensee, Kurt Campbell, owner of
12 Woody's Bar & Grill ("Licensee"), hereby enter into this stipulated settlement agreement for
13 LCB Case Number 22,762.

14 **I. INTRODUCTION**

15 The Washington State Liquor Control Board Education and Enforcement Division
16 issued an Administrative Violation Notice No. 4J7092D ("AVN") on April 18, 2007, to the
17 above-named Licensee with the following violations of the Washington State Liquor Act:

18 On April 2, 2007, the above named Licensee, or an employee(s) thereof, did sell, give,
19 or otherwise supply liquor to a person under the age of 21 years contrary to RCW 66.44.270
20 and allowed a person under the age of 21 years to frequent a restricted area contrary to
21 RCW 66.44.310.

22 Enforcement and the Licensee wish to enter into a settlement agreement concerning the
23 above-referenced AVN.

24 **II. AGREEMENT OF THE PARTIES**

25 Enforcement and the Licensee agree to the following:
26

1 1. Enforcement and the Licensee enter into this agreement to avoid the time and
2 expense of further litigation. The Licensee explicitly waives the right of further administrative
3 review of all matters related to this violation. The Licensee hereby voluntarily withdraws its
4 request for a hearing on the matter.

5 2. The Licensee admits to the violations in the above-referenced AVN. On
6 April 2, 2007, the above named Licensee, or an employee(s) thereof, did sell, give, or
7 otherwise supply liquor to a person under the age of 21 years and allowed a person under the
8 age of 21 years to frequent a restricted area.

9 3. The Licensee agrees to pay a monetary penalty of three hundred dollars (\$300);
10 this amount shall be paid within thirty (30) days of the date of the final order of the
11 Washington State Liquor Control Board. Payment shall be made to the Washington State
12 Liquor Control Board no later than 4:00 p.m. on the applicable date. In the event that the
13 Licensee does not make a timely payment, then and in that event, the Licensee shall serve a
14 three (3) day suspension of its liquor license, the dates and time of which shall be set by the
15 Washington State Liquor Control Board.

16 4. The parties recognize that this settlement agreement is subject to approval by
17 the Washington State Liquor Control Board.
