FINAL ORDER OF THE BOARD
ON LICENSING DIVISION'S
MOTION TO STRIKE CITY OF
SEATTLE'S HEARING REQUEST
ON THE 2007 LICENSE
RENEWAL

I. BOARD'S CONSIDERATION

The above entitled matter coming on regularly before the Board for its consideration and a final order.

II. PROCEDURAL BACKGROUND:

1. A licensing renewal matter for Wonderboyz, LLC d/b/a Wonderbar was initially heard and decided by the Board on July 31, 2007 whereby the 2007 license renewal was granted, over the objections to renewal submitted by the City of Seattle.
2. On August 8, 2007, Sharon Hendricks issued a letter informing the City of Seattle of the Board's decision.
3. On August 21, 2007, the City of Seattle submitted a request for reconsideration of the Board's decision and/or a hearing on the matter.
4. On September 6, 2007, Kevin McCarroll issued a letter acknowledging the hearing request to the City of Seattle.

5. On March 28, 2008, Licensing and Regulation Division submitted a Motion to Strike the hearing request from City of Seattle.
6. The Motion to Strike was properly served on the City of Seattle.
7. No reply to the Motion to Strike was received from the City of Seattle as of April 14, 2008 and the City of Seattle confirmed that they would not be submitting a reply.
8. The current license for Wonderbar is due to expire on May 31, 2008.
9. As a result of established procedure, the City of Seattle has received notice of the 2008 license renewal and has an opportunity to object.


The Board reviewed and considered the entire record and motion.

After consideration of the entire record on this matter, the Board grants the Licensing Division's Motion to Strike the City of Seattle's hearing request on the 2007 license renewal.

Reconsideration. Pursuant to RCW 34.05.470, you have ten (10) days from the mailing of this Order to file a petition for reconsideration stating the specific grounds on which relief is requested. No matter will be reconsidered unless it clearly appears from the petition for reconsideration that (a) there is material clerical error in the order or (b) there is specific material error of fact or law. A

petition for reconsideration, together with any argument in support thereof, should be filed by mailing or delivering it directly to the Washington State Liquor Control Board, Attn: Kevin McCarroll, 3000 Pacific Avenue Southeast, PO Box 43076, Olympia, WA 98504-3076, with a copy to all other parties of record and their representatives. Filing means actual receipt of the document at the Board's office. RCW 34.05.010(6). A copy shall also be sent to Linda Moran, Assistant Attorney General, 1125 Washington St. SE, P.O. Box 40110, Olympia, WA 98504-0110. A timely petition for reconsideration is deemed to be denied if, within twenty (20) days from the date the petition is filed, the agency does not (a) dispose of the petition or (b) serve the parties with a written notice specifying the date by which it will act on the petition. An order denying reconsideration is not subject to judicial review. RCW 34.05.470(5). The filing of a petition for reconsideration is not a prerequisite for filing a petition for judicial review.

Stay of Effectiveness. The filing of a petition for reconsideration does not stay the effectiveness of this Order. The Board has determined not to consider a petition to stay the effectiveness of this Order. Any such request should be made in connection with a petition for judicial review under chapter 34.05 RCW and RCW 34.05.550.

Judicial Review. Proceedings for judicial review may be instituted by filing a petition in superior court according to the procedures specified in chapter 34.05 RCW, Part V, Judicial Review and Civil Enforcement. The petition for judicial review of this Order shall be filed with the appropriate court and served on the Board, the Office of the Attorney General, and all parties within thirty days after service of the final order, as provided in RCW 34.05.542.

Service. This Order was served on you the day it was deposited in the United States mail. RCW 34.05.010(19).


