


THIS MATTER having come before the Washington State Liquor Control Board (Board) and the Washington State Liquor Control Board Education and Enforcement Division having been represented by its attorneys, ROBERT M. MCKENNA, Attorney General and THEODORE M. MILLER, Assistant Attorney General, and 7-ELEVEN 2303-26198B of Lakewood, WA, by and through Jaspal Rana, Licensee, and the parties having voluntarily entered into a stipulated settlement agreement for Liquor Control Board case numbers 22,781 and 22,782, arising from Administrative Violation Notices 1T7205A and 1T7226A, and the Board having considered the stipulated settlement agreement and the file materials maintained in these cases, now therefore:

1 IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the allegations set forth in Administrative Violation
2 Notices 1T7205A and 1T7226A are sustained and the stipulated Settlement Agreement and the
3 proposed penalty are approved. The Licensee shall serve a four-day (4) suspension
4 commencing Friday the 9th of May, 2008 at 10:00 a.m., and ending on
5 ~~Monday~~ ^{Tuesday}, the 13th of May, 2008 at 10:00 a.m. The Licensee shall further
6 pay a monetary penalty of \$300.00. Such penalty shall be paid within 30 days of the date of
7 this order. The Licensees shall make payment to: Washington State Liquor Control Board, PO
8 Box 43095, Olympia, WA 98504-3095.

STIPULATED SETTLEMENT
AGREEMENT

The Washington State Liquor Control Board Education and Enforcement Division (“Enforcement”) represented by its attorneys ROBERT M. MCKENNA, Attorney General and THEODORE M. MILLER, Assistant Attorney General and the Licensee, JASPAL and SURJIT RANA, d/b/a 7-Eleven 2303-26198B (“Licensee”) hereby enter into this stipulated settlement agreement for Liquor Control Board Case No. 22,781 and 22,782.

I. INTRODUCTION

The Washington State Liquor Control Board charged the above-named Licensee in its Complaints dated October 29, 2007, with the following violation of the Washington State Liquor Act:

On or about July 24, 2007, the Licensee and/or employee(s) thereof, did sell, give, or otherwise supply liquor to a person under the age of 21 years, contrary to RCW 66.44.270 and WAC 314-16-150.

On or about August 14, 2007, the licensee and/or employee(s) thereof, did sell, give, or otherwise supply liquor to a person under the age of 21 years, contrary to RCW 66.44.270 and WAC 314-16-150.

2 Enforcement and the Licensee wish to enter into a settlement agreement concerning the
3 above-referenced Complaint.

4 **II. AGREEMENT OF THE PARTIES**

5 Enforcement and the Licensee agree to the following:

6 1. Enforcement and the Licensee enter into this agreement to avoid the time and
7 expense of further litigation. The Licensee explicitly waives the right of further administrative
8 review of all matters related to this violation. The Licensee hereby voluntarily withdraws its
9 request for a hearing on the matter.

10 2. This agreement constitutes the final written expression of all the terms of this
11 agreement and is a complete and exclusive statement of these terms.

12 3. The Licensee admits to the violations set forth in the above-referenced
13 Complaints, that is, that on or about July 24, 2007, and on or about August 14, 2007, the
14 licensee and/or employee(s) thereof, did sell, give, or otherwise supply liquor to a person under
15 the age of 21 years, contrary to RCW 66.44.270 and WAC 314-16-150.

16 4. The parties agree that as a fist violation for supplying liquor to a person under
17 twenty-one (21), the standard penalty is a five (5) day suspension of the liquor license or a
18 monetary penalty of five hundred dollars (\$500). Further, the parties agree that a second
19 violation for supplying liquor to a person under twenty-one (21) years of age, the standard
20 penalty is a seven (7) day suspension of the Licensee's liquor license.

21 5. In lieu of suspension for the fist violation, the Licensee agrees to pay a
22 monetary penalty of three hundred dollars (\$300) for supplying liquor to a person under the
23 age of twenty-one. In lieu of the seven (7) days suspension of their liquor license for the
24 second violation of supplying liquor to a person under the age of twenty-one, the Licensee
25 agrees to a four (4) day suspension of their liquor license. The Licensee shall pay the monetary
26

1 penalty of three hundred dollars (\$300) no later than thirty (30) days after the date of the Final
2 Order of the Board. Payment shall be sent to:



6 6. In the event that the Licensee does not make a full and timely payment of the
7 monetary penalty as required in Section II, Paragraph 5, then the standard penalty of a twelve
8 (12) day suspension of the Licensee's liquor license shall be imposed.

9 7. The parties recognize that this settlement agreement is subject to approval by
10 the Washington State Liquor Control Board.


