THIS MATTER having come before the Washington State Liquor Control Board (Board) and the Washington State Liquor Control Board Education and Enforcement Division having been represented by its attorneys, ROBERT M. MCKENNA, Attorney General and RUTH AMMONS, Assistant Attorney General, and TROLLER BAR & GRILL of Suquamish, Washington, having been represented by ROHN and CARIN RUTLEDGE (Licensees), and the parties having voluntarily entered into a stipulated settlement agreement for Liquor Control Board case numbers 22791, 22792 and 22793, arising from Administrative Violation Notices 1V7230A, 1V7235A and 1V7279A, and the Board having considered the stipulated settlement agreement and the file materials maintained in this case, now therefore




IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the allegations set forth in Administrative Violation Notices 1V7230A, 1V7235A and 1V7279A are sustained and the Licensees shall pay a total

1 monetary penalty of \$4,800.00 to: Washington State Liquor Control Board, 6240 Tacoma
2 Mall Blvd., Suite 208, Tacoma, WA 98409-6819.

3 The Licensees shall pay the monetary penalty in three (3) separate payments of one
4 thousand six-hundred dollars (\$1,600.00) each. The first payment of one thousand six-hundred
5 dollars (\$1,600.00) shall be made no later than 30 days after the date of the Final Order of the
6 Board. The second payment of one thousand six-hundred dollars (\$1,600.00) shall be made no
7 later than 60 days after the date of the Final Order of the Board. The third and final payment
8 of one thousand six-hundred dollars (\$1,600.00) shall be made no later than 90 days after the
9 date of the Final Order of the Board. In the event that the Licensees do not make a full and
10 timely payment of the monetary penalty, then the Licensees shall serve a twelve (12) day
11 suspension of their liquor license, the dates and time of which shall be set by the Washington
12 State Liquor Control Board.

STIPULATED SETTLEMENT
AGREEMENT

The Washington State Liquor Control Board Education and Enforcement Division (Enforcement), by and through its attorneys, ROBERT M. MCKENNA, Attorney General and RUTH AMMONS, Assistant Attorney General and TROLLER BAR & GRILL of Suquamish, Washington, by and through ROHN and CARIN RUTLEDGE (Licensees), hereby enter into this stipulated settlement agreement for Liquor Control Board (LCB) case numbers 22791, 22792 and 22793, arising from Administrative Violation Notices (AVNs) 1V7230A, 1V7235A and 1V7279A.

I. INTRODUCTION

A. On September 12, 2007, Enforcement issued to the Licensees AVN No. 1V7230A, alleging that on August 18, 2007, the Licensees, or an employee(s) thereof, supplied or sold alcohol to an apparently intoxicated person, in violation of WAC 314-16-150.

B. On October 11, 2007, Enforcement issued to the Licensees AVN No. 1V7235A,

1 alleging that on August 23, 2007, the Licensees, or an employee(s) thereof, supplied or sold
2 alcohol to an apparently intoxicated person, in violation of WAC 314-16-150.

3 C. On October 11, 2007, Enforcement issued to the Licensees AVN No. 1V7279A,
4 alleging that on October 6, 2007, the Licensees, or an employee(s) thereof, supplied or sold
5 alcohol to an apparently intoxicated person, in violation of WAC 314-16-150.

6 II. AGREEMENT OF THE PARTIES

7 Prior to the filing of administrative complaints, Enforcement and the Licensees have
8 agreed to enter into the following settlement concerning AVN Nos. 1V7230A, 1V7235A and
9 1V7279A. Enforcement and the Licensees agree to the following:

10 1. Enforcement and the Licensees enter into this agreement to avoid the time and
11 expense of further litigation.

12 2. The Licensees explicitly waive the right of further administrative review of all
13 matters related to the above-referenced cases and AVNs. Furthermore, the Licensees hereby
14 voluntarily withdraw their requests for hearings in these matters.

15 3. This Agreement constitutes the final written expression of all the terms of this
16 Agreement and is a complete and exclusive statement of these terms.

17 4. The Licensees admit to the violations set forth in AVN Nos. 1V7230A,
18 1V7235A and 1V7279A:

19 a. On August 18, 2007, an employee of above-named Licensees supplied
20 or sold alcohol to an apparently intoxicated person;

21 b. On August 23, 2007, an employee of above-named Licensees supplied
22 or sold alcohol to an apparently intoxicated person; and

23 c. On October 6, 2007, an employee of above-named Licensees supplied or
24 sold alcohol to an apparently intoxicated person.

25 5. The Licensees agree to pay a total monetary penalty of four thousand eight-
26 hundred dollars (\$4,800.00), as a resolution of the three above-identified AVNs. The

1 Licensees shall pay the monetary penalty in three (3) separate payments of one thousand six-
2 hundred dollars (\$1,600.00) each. The first payment of one thousand six-hundred dollars
3 (\$1,600.00) shall be made no later than 30 days after the date of the Final Order of the Board.
4 The second payment of one thousand six-hundred dollars (\$1,600.00) shall be made no later
5 than 60 days after the date of the Final Order of the Board. The third and final payment of one
6 thousand six-hundred dollars (\$1,600.00) shall be made no later than 90 days after the date of
7 the Final Order of the Board. Payment shall be sent to:


12 6. In the event that the Licensees do not make full and timely payment of the
13 monetary penalty as required in Section II, Paragraph 5, then the Licensees shall serve a twelve
14 (12) day suspension of their liquor license, the dates and time of which shall be set by the
15 Washington State Liquor Control Board.

16 7. The parties recognize that this settlement agreement is subject to approval by
17 the WASHINGTON STATE LIQUOR CONTROL BOARD.


