The above-titled matter having come before the Board upon a Stipulated Settlement Agreement between the Enforcement Division of the Washington State Liquor Control Board and the Licensee, and the Board having reviewed the Stipulated Settlement Agreement:

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the Complaint filed in Liquor Control Board Case No. 22,794 is sustained and the Stipulated Settlement Agreement for Case No. 22,794 is approved. Accordingly, the Licensee shall pay a monetary penalty of two thousand five hundred dollars (\$2,500) in two (2) equal payments of one thousand two hundred fifty dollars (\$1,250). The first payment of one thousand two hundred fifty dollars (\$1,250) shall be made by the Licensee within thirty (30) days of the date of the Final Order of the Board. The second payment of one thousand two hundred fifty dollars (\$1,250) shall be made by the Licensee within sixty (60) days of the date of the Final Order of the Board. 

STIPULATED SETTLEMENT
AGREEMENT

The Washington State Liquor Control Board Education and Enforcement Division ("Enforcement") represented by its attorneys ROBERT M. MCKENNA, Attorney General and GORDON KARG, Assistant Attorney General and the Licensee, CHORAK'S SPORTSMAN'S INN, INC. ("Licensee") represented by PETER CHORAK, JR., hereby enter into this stipulated settlement agreement for Liquor Control Board Case No. 22,794.

I. INTRODUCTION

The Washington State Liquor Control Board charged the above-named Licensee in its Complaint dated November 27, 2007, with the following violation of the Washington State Liquor Act:

On or about September 27, 2007, the above-named Licensee or employee(s) thereof, supplied liquor to a person under twenty-one (21) years of age, contrary to RCW 66.44.270(1).

Enforcement and the Licensee wish to enter into a settlement agreement concerning the above-referenced Complaint.

1 **II. AGREEMENT OF THE PARTIES**

2 Enforcement and the Licensee agree to the following:

3 1. Enforcement and the Licensee enter into this agreement to avoid the time and
4 expense of further litigation. The Licensee explicitly waives the right of further administrative
5 review of all matters related to this violation. The Licensee hereby voluntarily withdraws its
6 request for a hearing on the matter.

7 2. This agreement constitutes the final written expression of all the terms of this
8 agreement and is a complete and exclusive statement of these terms.

9 3. The Licensee admits to the violation set forth in the above-referenced
10 Complaint. On September 27, 2007, the Licensee or employee(s) thereof supplied liquor to a
11 person under twenty-one (21) years of age, contrary to RCW 66.44.270(1).

12 4. The parties agree that as a second violation for supplying liquor to a person
13 under twenty-one (21) years of age, the standard penalty is a seven (7) day suspension of the
14 Licensee's liquor license.

15 5. In lieu of suspension, the Licensee agrees to pay a monetary penalty of two
16 thousand five hundred dollars (\$2,500). The Licensee shall pay the monetary penalty in two
17 (2) separate payments of one thousand two hundred and fifty dollars (\$1,250) each. The first
18 payment of one thousand two hundred and fifty dollars (\$1,250) shall be made no later than
19 thirty (30) days after the date of the Final Order of the Board. The second payment of one
20 thousand two hundred and fifty dollars (\$1,250) shall be made no later than sixty (60) days
21 after the date of the Final Order of the Board. Payment shall be sent to:

24 6. In the event that the Licensee does not make a full and timely payment of the
25 monetary penalty as required in Section II, Paragraph 5, then the standard penalty of a 7-day
26 suspension of the Licensee's liquor license shall be imposed.

1 7. The parties recognize that this settlement agreement is subject to approval by
2 the Washington State Liquor Control Board.
