






The Washington State Liquor Control Board Education and Enforcement Division (“Enforcement”) represented by its attorneys ROBERT M. MCKENNA, Attorney General and GORDON KARG, Assistant Attorney General and the Licensee, A. Frazier Inc., d/b/a Trinity Nightclub (“Licensee”), represented by ANDREW SCHWARTZ and SCOTT J. ENGELHARD, Attorneys at Law, hereby enter into this stipulated settlement agreement for case number 22,799.

**I. INTRODUCTION**

The Washington State Liquor Control Board charged the above-named Licensee in its Complaint dated January 23, 2008, with the following violation of the Washington State Liquor Act:

On or about August 26, 2007, the above-named Licensee, or an employee thereof, did sell, give, or otherwise supply liquor to a person under 21 (twenty-one) years of age, contrary to RCW 66.44.270.

1 Enforcement and the Licensee wish to enter into a settlement agreement concerning the  
2 above-referenced complaint.

3 **II. AGREEMENT OF THE PARTIES**

4 Enforcement and the Licensee agree to the following:

5 1. Enforcement and the Licensee enter into this agreement to avoid the time and  
6 expense of further litigation. The Licensee explicitly waives the right of further administrative  
7 review of all matters related to this violation. The Licensee hereby voluntarily withdraws its  
8 request for a hearing on the matter.

9 2. The parties agree that in lieu of penalty, Enforcement will convert the  
10 Administrative Violation Notice issued against the Licensee to a written warning and dismiss  
11 the complaint. The Seattle Enforcement Office shall issue the written warning.

12 3. The parties agree that a written warning does not constitute an admission by the  
13 Licensee of any violation of any Washington State liquor law or rule (violation); nor does it  
14 constitute a violation for the purposes of calculating any potential future penalties, suspensions  
15 or revocation under WAC 314-29-020, nor does it constitute a violation for the purposes of  
16 applying for or seeking to renew a liquor license under WAC 314-07-045. The written  
17 warning will become part of the Licensee's licensing history file.

18 4. The parties agree that all members of the Licensee's service and security staff  
19 will attend a Responsible Alcohol Sales Course at the Enforcement office closest to the  
20 licensed premise or have a Liquor Control Officer conduct a Responsible Alcohol Sales Course  
21 for all of the Licensee's staff at the licensed premise, within sixty (60) days of the date the  
22 Washington State Liquor Control Board issues its final order in LCB Case No. 22,799,  
23 approving this stipulated settlement agreement.




