

STIPULATED SETTLEMENT  
AGREEMENT

The Washington State Liquor Control Board Education and Enforcement Division (“Enforcement”) represented by its attorneys ROBERT M. MCKENNA, Attorney General and GORDON KARG, Assistant Attorney General and the Licensee, MIKE J. LAMMON d.b.a. THE IRONHEAD (“Licensee”) hereby enter into this stipulated settlement agreement for Liquor Control Board Case Number 22,803.

**I. INTRODUCTION**

The Washington State Liquor Control Board charged the above-named Licensee in its Complaint dated January 2, 2008, with the following violation of the Washington State Liquor Control Board Rules:

1. That on or about September 26, 2007 the Licensee was apparently intoxicated on the licensed premises in violation of WAC 314-11-015(3)(a).

Prior to a formal hearing on the matter, Enforcement and the Licensee wish to enter into a settlement agreement concerning the above-referenced complaint.

1 **II. AGREEMENT OF THE PARTIES**

2 Enforcement and the Licensee agree to the following:

3 1. Enforcement and the Licensee enter into this agreement to avoid the time and  
4 expense of further litigation. The Licensee explicitly waives the right of further administrative  
5 review of all matters related to the above-referenced complaint. The Licensee hereby  
6 voluntarily withdraws its request for hearing on the above-referenced complaint.

7 2. The Licensee admits to the violation set forth in the above-referenced  
8 complaint. On or about September 26, 2007, the Licensee was apparently intoxicated on the  
9 licensed premise in violation of WAC 314-11-015(3)(a).

10 3. The parties agree that the original penalty for this first violation of the Licensee  
11 being apparently intoxicated on the licensed premise contrary to WAC 314-11-015(3)(a) is a 5  
12 day suspension or a monetary penalty of \$500.

13 4. The Licensee agrees to pay a total monetary penalty of three hundred dollars  
14 (\$300) for the above-referenced complaint and the violation charged therein. This amount  
15 shall be paid within thirty (30) days of the date of the final order of the Washington State  
16 Liquor Control Board. Payment shall be made to the Washington State Liquor Control Board  
17 no later than 4:00 p.m. on the applicable date.

18 5. In the event that the Licensee does not make a timely payment, as required by  
19 Section II, Paragraph 4, the Licensee shall serve a five (5) day suspension of its liquor license,  
20 pursuant to WAC 314-29-020; the dates and time of which shall be set by the Washington  
21 State Liquor Control Board.


