THIS MATTER having come before the Washington State Liquor Control Board ("Board") and the Washington State Liquor Control Board Education and Enforcement Division ("Enforcement") having been represented by its attorneys, ROBERT M. MCKENNA, Attorney General and RUTH AMMONS, Assistant Attorney General, and LANCE PIRKLE, owner of BOOMBALL INC. d/b/a DRAFT PIC'S BAR & GRILL (Licensee), having been represented by KEN EVANS, and the parties having voluntarily entered into a stipulated settlement agreement for Liquor Control Board (LCB) No. 22,820, arising from Administrative Violation Notice (AVN) No. 3C8005A, and the Board having considered the stipulated settlement agreement and the file materials maintained in this case, now therefore

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the allegation set forth in AVN No. 3C8005A is sustained and within 30 days of the date of this Order, the Licensee shall pay a monetary

1 penalty of three hundred dollars (\$300.00) to: Washington State Liquor Control Board, 909
2 S.E. Everett Mall Way, Suite D-480, Everett, WA 98208-3757. In the event the Licensee fails
3 to make full and timely payment of the monetary penalty, the Licensee shall serve a three (3)
4 day suspension of its liquor license, the dates and time of which shall be set by the Washington
5 State Liquor Control Board.

STIPULATED SETTLEMENT
AGREEMENT

The Washington State Liquor Control Board Education and Enforcement Division (Enforcement) by and through its attorneys, ROBERT M. MCKENNA, Attorney General, and RUTH AMMONS, Assistant Attorney General, and LANCE PIRKLE, owner of BOOMBALL INC. d/b/a DRAFT PIC'S BAR & GRILL (Licensee), by and through his attorney, KEN EVANS, hereby enter into this stipulated settlement agreement for Liquor Control Board (LCB) No. 22,820, arising from Administrative Violation Notice (AVN) No. 3C8005A.

I. INTRODUCTION

The Washington State Liquor Control Board Enforcement Division issued to the Licensee AVN No. 3C8005A, alleging that on or about January 5, 2008, the Licensee, or employee(s) thereof, did allow a person apparently under the influence of liquor to possess and/or consume liquor on the licensed premises, contrary to WAC 314-16-150.

1 **II. AGREEMENT OF THE PARTIES**

2 Prior to the filing of an administrative complaint, Enforcement and the Licensee have
3 agreed to enter into the following settlement concerning AVN No. 3C8005A. Enforcement
4 and the Licensee agree to the following:

5 1. The parties enter into this agreement to avoid the time and expense of further
6 litigation.

7 2. The Licensee explicitly waives the right of further administrative review of all
8 matters related to the above-referenced AVN. Furthermore, the Licensee hereby voluntarily
9 withdraws his request for a hearing in this matter.

10 3. This Agreement constitutes the final written expression of all the terms of this
11 Agreement and is a complete and exclusive statement of these terms.

12 4. The Licensee admits to the violation set forth in AVN No. 3C8005A.
13 Specifically, on or about January 5, 2008, the Licensee, or employee(s) thereof, did allow a
14 person apparently under the influence of liquor to possess and/or consume liquor on the
15 licensed premises.

16 5. The Licensee agrees to pay a monetary penalty of three hundred dollars
17 (\$300.00) within 30 days of the date of the Final Order of the Board. Payment shall be sent to:

21 6. In the event that the Licensee fails to make full and timely payment of the
22 monetary penalty as required in Section II, Paragraph 5, the Licensee shall serve a three (3) day
23 suspension of its liquor license, the dates and time of which shall be set by the Washington
24 State Liquor Control Board.

2 the WASHINGTON STATE LIQUOR CONTROL BOARD.


