



STIPULATED SETTLEMENT

The Washington State Liquor Control Board Education and Enforcement Division (Enforcement) represented by its attorneys ROBERT M. MCKENNA, Attorney General and GORDON KARG, Assistant Attorney General and the Licensee, PENNY SAVER MART, INC. (Licensee) represented by PEGGY ANN BIERBAUM, hereby enter into this stipulated settlement agreement for Liquor Control Board Case No. 22,822.

I. INTRODUCTION

The Washington State Liquor Control Board charged the above-named Licensee in its Complaint dated April 10, 2008, with the following violation of the Washington State Liquor Act:

On or about January 26, 2008, the Licensee and/or employee(s) thereof, did sell, give, or otherwise supply liquor to a person under the age of 21 years, contrary to RCW 66.44.270(1) and WAC 314-16-150(1).

ORIGINAL

1 Enforcement and the Licensee wish to enter into a settlement agreement concerning the
2 above-referenced Complaint.

3 **II. AGREEMENT OF THE PARTIES**

4 Enforcement and the Licensee agree to the following:

5 1. Enforcement and the Licensee enter into this agreement to avoid the time and
6 expense of further litigation. The Licensee explicitly waives the right of further administrative
7 review of all matters related to this violation. The Licensee hereby voluntarily withdraws its
8 request for a hearing on the matter.

9 2. This agreement constitutes the final written expression of all the terms of this
10 agreement and is a complete and exclusive statement of these terms.

11 3. The Licensee admits to the violation set forth in the above-referenced
12 Complaint. On or about January 26, 2008, the Licensee and/or employee(s) thereof, did sell,
13 give, or otherwise supply liquor to a person under the age of 21 years, contrary to
14 RCW 66.44.270(1) and WAC 314-16-150(1).

15 4. The parties agree that the violation stipulated to in section II, paragraph 3 will
16 be recognized as the Licensee's second violation for supplying liquor to a person under twenty-
17 one (21) years of age within a twenty four (24) month period.

18 5. The Licensee agrees to serve a seven (7) day suspension of their liquor license
19 on the following consecutive dates: August 1, 2008; August 2, 2008; August 3, 2008; August
20 4, 2008; August 5, 2008, August 6, 2008 and August 7, 2008.


1 6. The parties recognize that this settlement agreement is subject to approval by
