
17 THIS MATTER having come before the Washington State Liquor Control Board  
18 (Board) and the Washington State Liquor Control Board Education and Enforcement Division  
19 having been represented by its attorneys, ROBERT M. MCKENNA, Attorney General, and  
20 BRIAN J. CONSIDINE, Assistant Attorney General, and ANGEL MCCLAIN d/b/a MAIN  
21 STREET STATION (Licensee) of Battle Ground, Washington, and the parties having  
22 voluntarily entered into a stipulated settlement agreement for Liquor Control Board No.  
23 22,823, arising from Administrative Violation Notice (AVN) No. 1J7290A, and the Board  
24 having considered the stipulated settlement agreement and Enforcement's Memorandum  
25 recommending acceptance of the stipulated settlement agreement, and the Board having had  
26 the opportunity to review the file materials maintained in this case, now therefore:


IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the violation set forth in Administrative Violation

16 The Washington State Liquor Control Board Education and Enforcement Division  
17 (Enforcement) by and through its attorneys, ROBERT M. MCKENNA, Attorney General and  
18 BRIAN J. CONSIDINE, Assistant Attorney General, and ANGEL MCCLAIN d/b/a MAIN  
19 STREET STATION (Licensee) of Battle Ground, Washington, hereby enter into this stipulated  
20 settlement agreement for Liquor Control Board.

21 **I. INTRODUCTION**

22 The Washington State Liquor Control Board Enforcement Division issued to the  
23 Licensee AVN No. 1J7290A, alleging that on or about October 17, 2007, the Licensee was  
24 disorderly or apparently intoxicated on the licensed premises, in violation of WAC 314-11-  
25 015(3)(a).

**II. AGREEMENT OF THE PARTIES**

Enforcement and the Licensee agree to the following:

1. The parties enter into this agreement to avoid the time and expense of further litigation.

2. The Licensee explicitly waives the right of further administrative review of all matters related to the above-referenced Complaint. Furthermore, the Licensee hereby voluntarily withdraws her request for a hearing in this matter.

3. This Agreement constitutes the final written expression of all the terms of this Agreement and is a complete and exclusive statement of these terms.

4. The Licensee admits to the violation set forth in AVN No. 1J7290A. Specifically, on or about October 17, 2007, the Licensee was apparently intoxicated on the licensed premises, in violation of WAC 314-11-015(3)(a).

5. The Licensee admits that subsequent to the issuance of the Complaint and her request for an administrative hearing, Licensee sold the business and she is no longer involved in the daily operations of the business.

6. The parties agree that the standard penalty of 5-days suspension or a \$500 fee is no longer a viable option, as the licensee has sold the business. The parties therefore agree that there will be no assessment of any fees or suspension associated with this violation.


