IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the Stipulated Settlement Agreement for Liquor Control Board Case Number 22,847 is approved.


1 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that within 30 days of the date of this Order and no later

The Washington State Liquor Control Board Education and Enforcement Division ("Enforcement") represented by its attorneys ROBERT M. MCKENNA, Attorney General and GORDON KARG, Assistant Attorney General and the Licensee, West One Inc. d/b/a Fast Eddie's All Purpose Pub ("Licensee") represented by DALE KLEIST, corporate officer of the Licensee, hereby enter into this stipulated settlement agreement for Liquor Control Board Case No. 22, 847.

**I. INTRODUCTION**

On May 1, 2008 Enforcement issued Administrative Violation Notice (AVN) No. 408095A to the above-named Licensee, charging the Licensee with the following alleged violation of the Washington State Liquor Act:

On or about March 13, 2008, the above-named Licensee or employee(s) thereof, allowed a person under twenty-one (21) years of age to enter and remain in the licensed premise which is off limits to persons under twenty-one (21) years of age, contrary to RCW 66.44.310(1)(a) and WAC 314-11-020(2).

1 Enforcement and the Licensee wish to enter into a settlement agreement concerning the  
2 above-referenced AVN and charge.

3 **II. AGREEMENT OF THE PARTIES**

4 Enforcement and the Licensee agree to the following:

5 1. Enforcement and the Licensee enter into this agreement to avoid the time and  
6 expense of further litigation. The Licensee explicitly waives the right of further administrative  
7 review of all matters related to the above-referenced violation. The Licensee hereby  
8 voluntarily withdraws its requests for a hearing in this matter.

9 2. This agreement constitutes the final written expression of all the terms of this  
10 agreement and is a complete and exclusive statement of these terms.

11 3. The parties agree that this Stipulated Settlement Agreement fully resolves all  
12 alleged violations charged in AVN No. 408095A such that no other enforcement action will arise  
13 out of AVN No. 408095A beyond the terms of this agreement.

14 4. The Licensee admits to the violation referenced above and charged in AVN No.  
15 408095A: that on or about March 13, 2008, the above-named Licensee or employee(s)  
16 thereof, allowed a person under twenty-one (21) years of age to enter and remain in the  
17 licensed premise which is off limits to persons under twenty-one (21) years of age, contrary to  
18 RCW 66.44.310(1)(a) and WAC 314-11-020(2).

19 5. The standard penalty for a first time violation of this type is a five day  
20 suspension of the liquor license or a five-hundred dollar (\$500) monetary penalty. WAC 314-  
21 29-020.

22 6. In lieu of the standard penalty, the Licensee agrees to pay a monetary penalty of  
23 three-hundred dollars (\$300) for the above admitted violation. This amount shall be paid  
24 within thirty (30) days of the date of the final order of the Washington State Liquor Control  
25 Board. Payment shall be made to the Washington State Liquor Control Board no later than  
26 4:00 p.m. on the applicable date. Payment shall be sent to:


7. In the event that the Licensee does not make a timely payment, as required by Section II, Paragraph 6, the Licensee shall serve a five (5) day suspension of its liquor license, pursuant to WAC 314-29-020; the dates and time of which shall be set by the Washington State Liquor Control Board.

8. The parties recognize that this settlement agreement is subject to approval by the Washington State Liquor Control Board.
