IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the allegation set forth in AVN No. 1L8138L is
sustained and within 30 days of the date of this Order, the Licensee shall pay a monetary

1 penalty of three hundred dollars (\$300.00) to: Washington State Liquor Control Board, 12501
2 NE 99th St., Suite A-100, Vancouver, WA 98682-2416. In the event the Licensee fails to make
3 full and timely payment of the monetary penalty, the Licensee shall serve a five (5) day
4 suspension of its liquor license, the dates and time of which shall be set by the Washington
5 State Liquor Control Board.

STIPULATED SETTLEMENT

The Washington State Liquor Control Board Education and Enforcement Division (Enforcement), by and through its attorneys, ROBERT M. MCKENNA, Attorney General, and RUTH AMMONS, Assistant Attorney General, and LEMCO, INC. d/b/a TENNANT WAY TEXACO (Licensee) by and through STEVEN LEMMONS, hereby enter into this stipulated settlement agreement for Liquor Control Board (LCB) No. 22851, arising from Administrative Violation Notice (AVN) No. 1L8138L.

I. INTRODUCTION

The Washington State Liquor Control Board Enforcement Division issued to the Licensee AVN No. 1L8138L, alleging that on or about May 17, 2008, the Licensee, or an employee thereof, sold or supplied liquor to a person under the age of twenty-one, contrary to RCW 66.44.270.

1 **II. AGREEMENT OF THE PARTIES**

2 Prior to the filing of an administrative complaint, Enforcement and the Licensee have
3 agreed to resolve AVN No. 1L8138L via settlement. Enforcement and the Licensee agree to
4 the following:

5 1. The parties enter into this agreement to avoid the time and expense of further
6 litigation.

7 2. The Licensee explicitly waives the right of further administrative review of all
8 matters related to the above-referenced AVN. Furthermore, the Licensee hereby voluntarily
9 withdraws its request for a hearing in this matter.

10 3. This Agreement constitutes the final written expression of all the terms of this
11 Agreement and is a complete and exclusive statement of these terms.

12 4. The Licensee admits to the violation set forth in AVN No. 1L8138L.
13 Specifically, on or about May 17, 2008, an employee of the Licensee sold or supplied liquor to
14 a person under the age of twenty-one.

15 5. The Licensee agrees to pay a monetary penalty of three hundred dollars
16 (\$300.00) within 30 days of the date of the Final Order of the Board. Payment shall be sent to:

20 6. In the event that the Licensee fails to make full and timely payment of the
21 monetary penalty as required in Section II, Paragraph 5, the Licensee shall serve a five (5) day

23 State Liquor Control Board.

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
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1 7. The parties recognize that this settlement agreement is subject to approval by
