


[PROPOSED]

THIS MATTER having come before the Washington State Liquor Control Board (“Board”) and the Washington State Liquor Control Board Education and Enforcement Division (“Enforcement”) having been represented by its attorneys, ROBERT M. MCKENNA, Attorney General and BRIAN J. CONSIDINE, Assistant Attorney General, and LA FAMILIA LOPEZ, INC. d/b/a EL PUEBLITO FAMILY MEXICAN RESTAURANT having been represented by CLIFFORD MOREY (Attorney for Licensee), and the parties having voluntarily entered into a stipulated settlement agreement for Liquor Control Board (LCB) No. 22870, arising from Administrative Violation Notice (AVN) No. 1V8249A, and the Board having considered the stipulated settlement agreement and the file materials maintained in this case, now therefore:

1 IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the allegation set forth in AVN No. 1V8249A is sustained and
2 within 30 days of the date of this Order, the Licensee shall pay a monetary penalty of three
3 hundred dollars (\$300.00) to: Washington State Liquor Control Board, P.O. Box 43094,
4 Olympia, Washington, 98504. In the event the Licensee fails to make full and timely payment
5 of the monetary penalty, the Licensee shall serve a five (5) day suspension of its liquor license,
6 the dates and time of which shall be set by the Washington State Liquor Control Board.

STIPULATED SETTLEMENT
AGREEMENT

The Washington State Liquor Control Board Education and Enforcement Division (Enforcement), by and through its attorneys, ROBERT M. MCKENNA, Attorney General and BRIAN J. CONSIDINE, Assistant Attorney General and the Licensee, LA FAMILIA LOPEZ, INC. d/b/a EL PUEBLITO FMAILY MEXICAN RESTAURANT, represented by CLIFFORD MOREY, Attorney for Licensee, hereby enter into this stipulated settlement agreement for case number 22,870, arising from Administrative Violation Notice (AVN) No. 1V8249A.

I. INTRODUCTION

1. The Washington State Liquor Control Board charged the above-named Licensee in its Complaint dated October 22, 2008, with the following violation of the Washington State Liquor Act:

On or about September 5, 2008, the above-named Licensee, or an employee(s) thereof, sold liquor to a person apparently under the influence of liquor, contrary to RCW 66.44.200(1) and WAC 314-16-150.

1 7. The parties recognize that this settlement agreement is subject to approval by
2 the Washington State Liquor Control Board.




