FINAL ORDER OF THE BOARD

The above entitled matter coming on regularly before the Board, and it appearing that:

1. A prehearing conference was scheduled for September 18, 2009 at the licensee's timely request for a formal administrative hearing.

2. The Liquor Control Board's Complaint dated March 19, 2009, alleged that on or about July 10, 2008, the above-named Licensee, or employee(s) thereof, sold, gave, or otherwise supplied liquor to a person(s) under twenty-one (21) years of age, in violation of RCW 66.44.270 and WAC 314-11-020(1). Or in the alternative: That on or about July 10, 2008, the above-named Licensee, or employee(s) thereof, allowed a person(s) under twenty-one (21) years of age to enter and remain in a licensed premises or an area of a licensed premises off-limits to persons under the age of twenty-one (21), in violation of RCW 66.44.310(1)(a) and WAC 314-11-020(2).

3. The Appellant did not appear for the prehearing conference nor request a continuance. The Education and Enforcement Division of the Board was represented by Assistant Attorney General Gordon Karg.

4. On December 28, 2009, Administrative Law Judge Christy Gerhart Cufley entered her Proposed Default Order, ordering that the appellant was in default and dismissing the appeal.

5. No request to vacate the default was filed.

6. The entire record in this proceeding was presented to the Board for final decision, and the Board having fully considered said record and being fully advised in the premises; NOW THEREFORE; IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the default order for case 22,880 is adopted.

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED that the violation set forth in Administrative Violation Notice No. 2X8214B is SUSTAINED and that the standard penalty of a seven (7) day suspension is imposed; however, as the licensee has sold the business, the suspension will not be served, but this violation will be considered by the Board in the event the licensee (or its officers) applies for a license in the future.

Reconsideration. Pursuant to RCW 34.05.470, you have ten (10) days from the mailing of this Order to file a petition for reconsideration stating the specific grounds on which relief is requested. A petition for reconsideration, together with any argument in support thereof, should be filed by mailing or delivering it directly to the Washington State Liquor Control Board, Attn: Kevin McCarroll, 3000 Pacific Avenue Southeast, PO Box 43076, Olympia, WA 98504-3076, with a copy to all other parties of record and their representatives. Filing means actual receipt of the document at the Board's office. RCW 34.05.010(6). A copy shall also be sent to Mary M. Tennyson, Senior Assistant Attorney General, 1125 Washington St. SE, P.O. Box 40110, Olympia, WA 98504-0110. A timely petition for reconsideration is deemed to be denied if, within twenty (20) days from the date the petition is filed, the agency does not (a) dispose of the petition or (b) serve the parties with a written notice specifying the date

by which it will act on the petition. An order denying reconsideration is not subject to judicial review. RCW 34.05.470(5). The filing of a petition for reconsideration is not a prerequisite for filing a petition for judicial review.

Stay of Effectiveness. The filing of a petition for reconsideration does not stay the effectiveness of this Order. The Board has determined not to consider a petition to stay the effectiveness of this Order. Any such request should be made in connection with a petition for judicial review under chapter 34.05 RCW and RCW 34.05.550.

Judicial Review. Proceedings for judicial review may be instituted by filing a petition in superior court according to the procedures specified in chapter 34.05 RCW, Part V, Judicial Review and Civil Enforcement. The petition for judicial review of this Order shall be filed with the appropriate court and served on the Board, the Office of the Attorney General, and all parties within thirty days after service of the final order, as provided in RCW 34.05.542.


