

CARR, and the Board having considered the City's Request for a Hearing, Licensing's Response to City of Seattle's Request for Hearing, and the file materials maintained in this case hereby FINDS:

1. The City was given proper notice of its right to appeal the Board's decision to renew the Applicant's liquor license;
2. The City had twenty (20) days from November 17, 2008, to request a hearing on the Licensee's liquor license renewal, and it did not submit its hearing request until December 12, 2008, twenty-four (24) days after it received notice for appeal;
