


The parties having voluntarily entered into a stipulated settlement agreement for Liquor Control Board Case No. 22,896, and the Board having reviewed and considered the stipulated settlement agreement and Enforcement's Memorandum recommending acceptance of the stipulated settlement agreement, now therefore:

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the Stipulated Settlement Agreement for Liquor Control Board Case Number 22,896 is approved in its entirety.

1 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that no additional penalty, monetary or otherwise, will be
2 assessed against the licensee as their license has been previously revoked and it has ceased
3 selling liquor of any kind.

STIPULATED SETTLEMENT
AGREEMENT

The Washington State Liquor Control Board Education and Enforcement Division ("Enforcement") by and through its attorneys, ROBERT M. MCKENNA, Attorney General and GORDON P. KARG, Assistant Attorney General and CHANG SIK CHOE, owner of NEWMAN'S CHEVRON ("Licensee"), of Bremerton, Washington, by and through their attorney, MICHAEL YAHNG, hereby enter into this stipulated settlement agreement for Liquor Control Board Case No. 22,896.

I. INTRODUCTION

On February 18, 2009 the Washington State Liquor Control Board charged, via formal Complaint, the Licensee with the following violation of the Washington State Liquor Act and Rules and Regulations of the Board: That on or about November 1, 2008, the above-named Licensee or employee(s) thereof, sold, gave or otherwise supplied liquor to a person under twenty-one (21) years of age, contrary to RCW 66.44.270(1) and WAC 314-11-020(1).

II. AGREEMENT OF THE PARTIES

Prior to a formal hearing on the matter, Enforcement and the Licensee have agreed to resolve Case No. 22,896 via settlement. Enforcement and the Licensee agree to the following:

1. The parties enter into this agreement to avoid the time and expense of further litigation.

2. The Licensee explicitly waives the right of further administrative review of all matters related to the above-referenced Complaint and case. Furthermore, the Licensees hereby voluntarily withdraw their request for a hearing in this matter.

3. This Agreement constitutes the final written expression of all the terms of this Agreement and is a complete and exclusive statement of these terms.

4. The Licensee admits to the violation set forth in the Complaint. Specifically, on or about November 1, 2008, the above-named Licensee or employee(s) thereof, sold, gave or otherwise supplied liquor to a person under twenty-one (21) years of age, contrary to RCW 66.44.270(1) and WAC 314-11-020(1).

5. The Licensee admits that prior to entering into this settlement agreement with Enforcement the Washington State Liquor Control Board cancelled and revoked their liquor license pursuant to another matter. The Licensee admits they have subsequently closed their establishment and have ceased doing business of any kind.


6. The parties agree that the prior revocation of the Licensee's liquor license will act in lieu of any assessment of penalties or fees for this violation. The parties therefore agree that there will be no assessment of any additional penalties or fees associated with this violation.




