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
1 IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the allegation set forth in AVN No. 1P9051F is

The Washington State Liquor Control Board Education and Enforcement Division (Enforcement), by and through its attorneys, ROBERT M. MCKENNA, Attorney General and BRIAN J. CONSIDINE, Assistant Attorney General and E-Z FOOD STORE of Tacoma, Washington, by and through JOHN JUNGHOON PARK (Licensee), hereby enter into this stipulated settlement agreement for Liquor Control Board (LCB) case number 23,509, arising from Administrative Violation Notice (AVN) No. 1P9051F.

I. INTRODUCTION

1. The Washington State Liquor Control Board Enforcement Division issued to the Licensee AVN No. 1P9051F alleging that on or about February 20, 2009, the above-named Licensee, or an employee(s) thereof, sold or supplied liquor to a person under the age of twenty-one, contrary to RCW 66.44.270 and WAC 314-16-150(1).

2. Enforcement and the Licensee wish to enter into a settlement agreement concerning the above-referenced AVN.

1 **II. AGREEMENT OF THE PARTIES**

2 Prior to the filing of an administrative complaint, Enforcement and the Licensee have
3 agreed to resolve AVN No. 1P9051F via settlement. Enforcement and the Licensee agree to
4 the following:

5 1. The parties enter into this agreement to avoid the time and expense of further
6 litigation.

7 2. The Licensee explicitly waives the right of further administrative review of all
8 matters related to both of the above-referenced cases and AVN's. Furthermore, the Licensee
9 hereby voluntarily withdraws its request for a hearing in this matter.

10 3. This Agreement constitutes the final written expression of all the terms of this
11 Agreement, and it is a complete and exclusive statement of these terms.

12 4. The Licensee admits to the violation set forth in AVN No. 1P9051F.
13 Specifically, on or about February 20, 2009, an employee of the Licensee sold liquor to a
14 person under the age of twenty-one, contrary to RCW 66.44.270 and WAC 314-16-150(1).

15 5. The Licensee agrees to pay a monetary penalty of three hundred dollars
16 (\$300.00) within 30 days of the date of the Final Order of the Board. Payment shall be sent to:

22 6. In the event that the Licensee fails to make full and timely payment of the
23 monetary penalty as required in Section II, Paragraph 5, the Licensee shall serve a five (5) day
24 suspension of its liquor license, the dates and time of which shall be set by the Washington
25 State Liquor Control Board.

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1 7. The parties recognize that this settlement agreement is subject to approval by
2 the Washington State Liquor Control Board.
