THIS MATTER having come before the Washington State Liquor Control Board (Board) and the Washington State Liquor Control Board Education and Enforcement Division having been represented by its attorneys, ROBERT M. MCKENNA, Attorney General and RUTH AMMONS, Assistant Attorney General, and ROHN and CARIN RUTLEDGE d/b/a TROLLER BAR & GRILL (Licensees) of Suquamish, Washington, having been represented by their attorney, STEVEN OLSEN, and the parties having voluntarily entered into a stipulated settlement agreement for Liquor Control Board case number 23,522, arising from Administrative Violation Notice 1W9019A, and the Board having considered the stipulated settlement agreement and the file materials maintained in this case, now therefore

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the Complaint filed in LCB case number 23,522 is sustained.

1 It is FURTHER ORDERED that the Licensees shall serve an eighty (80) day  
2 suspension of their liquor license, effective February 2, 2010 at NOON through  
3 April 23, 2010 at NOON.

4 It is FURTHER ORDERED that the Licensees shall pay a total monetary penalty of  
5 eight thousand dollars (\$8,000.00). The Licensees shall pay the monetary penalty in three (3)  
6 separate payments. The first payment of two thousand six hundred and sixty-six dollars  
7 (\$2,666.00) shall be made within thirty (30) days of the date of this Order. The second  
8 payment of two-thousand six-hundred and sixty-seven dollars (\$2,667.00) shall be made within  
9 thirty (30) days the expiration of the license suspension set forth above. The third and final  
10 payment of two-thousand six-hundred and sixty-seven dollars (\$2,667.00) shall be made within  
11 sixty (60) days after days after the expiration of the license suspension. Payment shall be sent  
12 to: Washington State Liquor Control Board, P.O. Box 43085, Olympia, WA 98504-3085.

13 It is FURTHER ORDERED that in the event the Licensees do not fully and timely  
14 satisfy the penalties set forth herein, then the standard penalty shall be imposed and the license  
15 (No. 355184) shall be cancelled.

The Washington State Liquor Control Board (LCB) Education and Enforcement Division (Enforcement), by and through its attorneys, ROBERT M. MCKENNA, Attorney General and RUTH AMMONS, Assistant Attorney General, and ROHN and CARIN RUTLEDGE d/b/a TROLLER BAR & GRILL of Suquamish, Washington, by and through their attorney, STEVEN OLSEN, hereby enter into this stipulation and settlement agreement for LCB case No. 23,522 (AVN No. 1W9019A).

**I. INTRODUCTION**

In LCB case No. 23,522, the Washington State Liquor Control Board by Complaint dated July 7, 2009, based on AVN No. 1W9019A, alleged that on or about January 19, 2009, the Licensees or employee(s) thereof sold and/or supplied liquor to a liquor to a person apparently under the influence of liquor and/or allowed a person who was apparently under the influence of liquor to possess and/or consume liquor on the licensed premises, contrary to RCW 66.44.200 and WAC 314-16-150.

1 **II. AGREEMENT OF THE PARTIES**

2 Enforcement and the Licensees agree to the following:

3 1. Enforcement and the Licensees enter into this agreement to avoid the time and  
4 expense of further litigation.

5 2. The Licensees explicitly waive the right of further administrative review of all  
6 matters related to the above-referenced Complaint. Furthermore, the Licensees hereby  
7 voluntarily withdraw their request for a hearing in this matter.

8 3. This Agreement constitutes the final written expression of all the terms of this  
9 Agreement and is a complete and exclusive statement of these terms.

10 4. The Licensees admit to the violation set forth in the Complaint. Specifically,  
11 the Licensees stipulate that on or about January 19, 2009, an employee of the Licensees sold  
12 and/or supplied liquor to an apparently intoxicated person and/or allowed an apparently  
13 intoxicated person to possess and/or consume liquor on the licensed premises.

14 5. The parties agree that this is the fourth violation of its type within a two-year  
15 period, and as such, the standard penalty is cancellation of the license.

16 6. In consideration of and for this settlement agreement, the Licensees agree to  
17 serve an eighty (80) day suspension of their liquor license, the dates and time of which shall be  
18 set by the Washington State Liquor Control Board, but in no event shall the suspension begin  
19 earlier than thirty days after the date of the Final Order of the Board. In addition, Licensees  
20 agree to pay a total monetary penalty of eight-thousand dollars (\$8,000.00). The Licensees  
21 shall pay the monetary penalty in three (3) separate payments. The first payment of two  
22 thousand six hundred and sixty-six dollars (\$2,666.00) shall be made no later than thirty days  
23 after the date of the Final Order of the Board. The second payment of two-thousand six-  
24 hundred and sixty-seven dollars (\$2,667.00) shall be made no later than 30 days after the  
25 expiration of the license suspension. The third and final payment of two-thousand six-hundred  
26 and sixty-seven dollars (\$2,667.00) shall be made no later than 60 days after days after the

1 expiration of the license suspension. Payment shall be sent to:

5 7. In the event that the Licensees do not fully any timely satisfy the penalties set  
6 forth in Section II, Paragraph 6, then the standard penalty of license cancellation shall be  
7 imposed.

8 8. The parties recognize that this settlement agreement is subject to approval by  
9 the WASHINGTON STATE LIQUOR CONTROL BOARD.




