MCKENNA, Attorney General and BRIAN J. CONSIDINE, Assistant Attorney General, and COMEDY ALCOHOL CERTIFICATION of Seattle, Washington, by and through DAVID B. DENNISON, Provider, and the parties having voluntarily entered into a stipulated settlement agreement for LCB No. 23,523, arising from violations set forth in the letter dated March 4, 2009, from Kim Sauer, Mandatory Alcohol Server Training (M.A.S.T.) Coordinator, the Board having considered the stipulated settlement agreement and Licensing's Memorandum recommending acceptance of the stipulated settlement agreement, and the Board having had the opportunity to review the file materials maintained in this case, now therefore:

1 IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that:

- 2 1. The allegations set forth in the letter dated March 4, 2009, alleging that on, about,
3 and during August 2008 through October 2008, the above-named Provider, failed to
4 keep or maintain records for M.A.S.T. permit classes taught by Ms. Heidi Hansen,
5 in violation of RCW 66.20.310, RCW 66.20.340, WAC 314-17-085, and WAC
6 314-17-100 is sustained.

7 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that:

- 8 1. The Provider shall:

9 a. Prior to July 15, 2009:

- 10 i. Report a complete list of current permit forms in stock; and
11 ii. Successfully complete the record inspection by the Board staff.

12 b. From July 15, 2009 until December 31, 2009:

- 13 i. Email all class schedules to the M.A.S.T. Coordinator prior to
14 conducting any M.A.S.T. class; and
15 ii. Submit, via e-mail, an Excel spreadsheet, which reports all class
16 information, including: names of participants; permit numbers issued
17 to them; date and location of the class. This must be submitted
18 within 24 hours after any M.A.S.T. permit class.

19 c. At all times:

- 20 i. Submit to the M.A.S.T. Coordinator at the Washington State Liquor
21 Control Board any proposed changes made to the Provider's
22 program content or method of presentation;
23 ii. Only present content or utilize methods of presentation approved by
24 the M.A.S.T. Coordinator at the Washington State Liquor Control




- iii. Immediately notify his trainers and revise any teaching materials upon notification of new rules and regulations by the Washington State Liquor Control Board;
- iv. Ensure that all trainers use the most recent M.A.S.T. permit training materials; and
- v. Cooperate with the Washington State Liquor Control Board in all efforts to improve the quality and effectiveness of his M.A.S.T. permit trainings.

2. In the event that the Provider fails to comply with any of the restrictions set forth in Section II, Paragraph 5(a), (b), or (c), the Provider shall serve an immediate six (6) month suspension of his certification, the dates and time of which shall be set by the Washington State Liquor Control Board.

STIPULATED SETTLEMENT

The Washington State Liquor Control Board Education and Enforcement Division (Enforcement), by and through its attorneys, ROBERT M. MCKENNA, Attorney General and BRIAN J. CONSIDINE, Assistant Attorney General and COMEDY ALCOHOL CERTIFICATION of Seattle, Washington, by and through DAVID B. DENNISON (owner), hereby enter into this stipulated settlement agreement for Liquor Control Board (LCB) case numbers 23,523, arising from violations set forth in the letter dated March 4, 2009, from Kim Sauer, Mandatory Alcohol Server Training (M.A.S.T.) Coordinator.

I. INTRODUCTION

1. The Washington State Liquor Control Board Licensing Division's Mandatory Alcohol Server Training (M.A.S.T.) Coordinator issued Mr. Dennison a notice of violations in a letter dated March 4, 2009, alleging that on, about, and during August 2008 through October 2008, the above-named Provider, failed to keep or maintain records for M.A.S.T. permit

1 classes taught by Ms. Heidi Hansen, in violation of RCW 66.20.310, RCW 66.20.340, WAC
2 314-17-085, and WAC 314-17-100.

3 2. Licensing and the Provider wish to enter into a settlement agreement concerning
4 the above-referenced violations.

5 **II. AGREEMENT OF THE PARTIES**

6 Prior to the filing of administrative complaints, Enforcement and the Provider have
7 agreed to resolve the above-referenced violations via settlement. Enforcement and the
8 Provider agree to the following:

9 1. The parties enter into this agreement to avoid the time and expense of further
10 litigation.

11 2. The Licensee explicitly waives the right of further administrative review of all
12 matters related to the above-referenced violations. Furthermore, the Licensee hereby
13 voluntarily withdraws its request for a hearing in this matter.

14 3. This Agreement constitutes the final written expression of all the terms of this
15 Agreement, and it is a complete and exclusive statement of these terms.

16 4. The Licensee admits to the violations set forth in Ms. Sauer's letter dated March
17 4, 2009. Specifically, on, about, and during August 2008 through October 2008, the Provider
18 failed to report permit numbers issued by Heidi Hansen in August, September, and October of
19 2008, in violation of RCW 66.20.310, RCW66.20.340, WAC 314-17-085, and WAC 314-17-
20 100.

21 5. The Provider agrees to the following restrictions:

22 a. Prior to July 15, 2009, the Provider will:

- 23 i. Report a complete list of current permit forms in stock; and
24 ii. Successfully complete the record inspection by the Board staff.

- 1 b. Starting July 15, 2009 until December 31, 2009, the Provider will:
- 2 i. Email all class schedules to the M.A.S.T. Coordinator prior to

- 5 information, including: names of participants; permit numbers issued
