
1 IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that AVN Number 6D8330C for Case Number 23,527 is
2 sustained; and within thirty (30) days of this order, the Licensee shall pay a monetary penalty
3 of three hundred dollars (\$300.00) to:

7 In the event the Licensee fails to make full and timely payment of the monetary penalty, the
8 Licensee shall serve a three (3) day suspension of its liquor license, the dates and time of which
9 shall be set by the Washington State Liquor Control Board.

STIPULATED SETTLEMENT
AGREEMENT

The Washington State Liquor Control Board Education and Enforcement Division (Enforcement) represented by its attorneys, ROBERT M. MCKENNA, Attorney General, and BRIAN J. CONSIDINE, Assistant Attorney General, and the Licensee, GRANDE RONDE CELLARS, LLC d/b/a GRANDE RONDE CELLARS through its representative, DAVID WESTFALL, hereby enter into this stipulated settlement agreement for Liquor Control Board Case Number 23,527.

I. INTRODUCTION

1. The Washington State Liquor Control Board Education and Enforcement Division issued an Administrative Violation Notice No. 6D8330C (AVN) on November 25, 2008, to the above-named Licensee specifying the following violation of the Washington State Liquor Act:

1 On or about May 5, 2008 through October 31, 2008, the above-named Licensee
2 allowed an unlicensed agent to canvass for, solicit, receive or take orders for the
purchase of sale of liquor, contrary to RCW 66.24.310 and/or WAC 314-44-005.

3 2. Enforcement and the Licensee wish to enter into a settlement agreement
4 concerning the above-referenced AVN.

5 **II. AGREEMENT OF THE PARTIES**

6 Prior to the filing of an administrative complaint, Enforcement and the Licensee have
7 agreed to resolve the above-reference AVN via settlement. Enforcement and the Licensee
8 agree to the following:

9 1. Enforcement and the Licensee enter into this agreement to avoid the time and
10 expense of further litigation. The Licensee explicitly waives the right of further administrative
11 review of all matters related to this violation. The Licensee hereby voluntarily withdraws its
12 request for a hearing on this matter.

13 2. The Licensee admits to the violation in the above-referenced AVN, that is, on or
14 about May 5, 2008 through October 31, 2008, the above-named Licensee allowed an
15 unlicensed agent to canvass for, solicit, receive, or take orders for the purchase of sale of
16 liquor, contrary to RCW 66.24.310 and/or WAC 314-44-005.

17 3. The parties agree that the standard penalty for a first violation for allowing an
18 unlicensed agent to act on behalf of the Licensee is a three (3) day suspension of its liquor
19 license or a five-hundred dollar (\$500) monetary penalty. .

20 4. The parties agree that that the penalty for the above mentioned AVN shall be a
21 three (3) day suspension of the liquor license or a three-hundred dollar (\$300) monetary
22 penalty. The Licensee hereby chooses to pay the monetary penalty of three-hundred dollars
23 (\$300).

24 5. The Licensee shall pay the monetary penalty of three-hundred dollars (\$300) no
25 later than thirty (30) days after the date of the Final Order of the Board. Payment shall be sent



4 6. If the Licensee subsequently fails to make a full and timely payment of the
5 penalty as required in Section II, Paragraph 4 and 5, then the penalty of a three (3) day
6 suspension of the Licensee's liquor license shall be imposed.


7 7. The parties recognize that this settlement agreement is subject to approval by
8 the Washington State Liquor Control Board.

9 8. This agreement constitutes the final written expression of all the terms of this
10 agreement and is a complete and exclusive statement of these terms.
