

THIS MATTER having come before the Washington State Liquor Control Board (Board) and The Washington State Liquor Control Board Education and Enforcement Division (Enforcement) represented by its attorneys ROBERT M. MCKENNA, Attorney General and GORDON KARG, Assistant Attorney General and the Licensee, Sarodo Inc. d/b/a SP Mart (Licensee) represented by SOLOMAN KIM, Attorney at Law, and the Board having considered the stipulated settlement agreement and Enforcement's memorandum recommending acceptance of the settlement agreement, and the Board having had the opportunity to review the file materials maintained in these cases, now therefore:

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the Stipulated Settlement Agreement for Case Numbers 23, 543; 23, 544 and 23,545 is approved, that the violation charged in Administrative Violation Notice No. 2Z9042A shall be converted to a written warning and the violations charged in Administrative Violation Notice No's. 2C9065A and 2C9100A are sustained, and

1 the Licensee's cessation of business operations and voluntarily relinquishing of its liquor  
2 license shall act in lieu of the combined standard penalties.

3 FURTHERMORE the Licensee will not seek to reapply for a liquor license from the  
4 Washington State Liquor Control Board for a period of three years from the date of this final  
5 order.

The Washington State Liquor Control Board Education and Enforcement Division (Enforcement) represented by its attorneys, ROBERT M. MCKENNA, Attorney General, and GORDON KARG, Assistant Attorney General, and the Licensee, Sarodo Inc. d/b/a SP Mart (Licensee) represented by SOLOMAN KIM, Attorney at Law, hereby enter into this stipulated settlement agreement for Liquor Control Board Case No's. 23, 543; 23, 544; and 23,545.

**I. INTRODUCTION**

The Washington State Liquor Control Board charged the above-named Licensee, in three separate Administrative Violation Notices, with the following violations of the Washington Liquor Control Board Rules:

1. AVN No. 2Z9042A: on or about January 24, 2009 the above-named Licensee or employee(s) thereof, served, sold or otherwise supplied a person under twenty-one (21) years of age an alcoholic beverage contrary to RCW 66.44.270(1).

2 6. The Licensee acknowledges AVN No. 2C9065A and AVN No. 2C9100A are the  
3 Licensee's second and third violation of this type, which carry a standard penalty of a seven and  
4 thirty day suspension, respectively, of the liquor license.

5 7. The Licensee acknowledges it has terminated its business operations,  
6 voluntarily relinquished its liquor license and no longer has an interest in the license at issue.


7 8. The parties agree that the Licensee's cessation of business operations and the  
8 voluntarily relinquishing of its liquor license have effectively mooted Enforcement's actions  
9 and shall act in lieu of the standard penalty.

10 9. The parties agree that the Licensee will not seek to reapply for a liquor license  
11 from the Washington State Liquor Control Board for a period of three years from the date of  
12 the final order in this matter. The parties agree that this agreement in no way reflects a  
13 guarantee, implicit or explicit, that the Licensee will be issued a liquor license if the Licensee  
14 applies for a liquor license after the three year period elapses.


15 11. The parties recognize that this settlement agreement is subject to approval by
