

15 THIS MATTER having come before the Washington State Liquor Control Board  
16 (Board) and the Washington State Liquor Control Board Education and Enforcement Division  
17 (Enforcement) having been represented by its attorneys, ROBERT M. MCKENNA, Attorney  
18 General, and RUTH AMMONS, Assistant Attorney General, and PRIYANA, INC. d/b/a  
19 RENTON 76 (Licensee) having been represented by DAVID MALIK, *pro se*, and the parties  
20 having voluntarily entered into a stipulated settlement agreement for LCB No. 23569, arising  
21 from Administrative Violation Notice (AVN) No. 2M9128B, and the Board having considered  
22 the stipulated settlement agreement and Enforcement's Memorandum recommending  
23 acceptance of the stipulated settlement agreement, and the Board having had the opportunity to  
24 review the file materials maintained in this case, now therefore:

1 IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the allegation set forth in AVN No. 2M9128B is  
2 sustained and within 30 days of the date of this Order, the Licensee shall pay a monetary  
3 penalty of three-hundred fifty dollars (\$350.00) to: Washington State Liquor Control Board,  
4 P.O. Box 43085, Olympia, WA 98504-3085. In the event the Licensee fails to make full and  
5 timely payment of the monetary penalty, the Licensee shall serve a three (3) day suspension of  
6 its liquor license, the dates and time of which shall be set by the Washington State Liquor  
7 Control Board.

STIPULATED SETTLEMENT  
AGREEMENT

The Washington State Liquor Control Board Education and Enforcement Division (Enforcement), by and through its attorneys, ROBERT M. MCKENNA, Attorney General, and RUTH AMMONS, Assistant Attorney General, and PRIYANA, INC. d/b/a RENTON 76 (Licensee) by and through DAVID MALIK, hereby enter into this stipulated settlement agreement for Liquor Control Board (LCB) No. 23569, arising from Administrative Violation Notice (AVN) No. 2M9128B.

**I. INTRODUCTION**

The Washington State Liquor Control Board Enforcement Division issued to the Licensee AVN No. 2M9128B, alleging that on or about May 8, 2009, the Licensee, or an employee thereof, sold or supplied liquor to a person under the age of twenty-one, contrary to RCW 66.44.270.

1 **II. AGREEMENT OF THE PARTIES**

2 Prior to the filing of an administrative complaint, Enforcement and the Licensee have  
3 agreed to resolve AVN No. 2M9128B via settlement. Enforcement and the Licensee agree to  
4 the following:

5 1. The parties enter into this agreement to avoid the time and expense of further  
6 litigation.

7 2. The Licensee explicitly waives the right of further administrative review of all  
8 matters related to the above-referenced AVN. Furthermore, the Licensee hereby voluntarily  
9 withdraws its request for a hearing in this matter.

10 3. This Agreement constitutes the final written expression of all the terms of this  
11 Agreement and is a complete and exclusive statement of these terms.

12 4. The Licensee stipulates to the violation set forth in AVN No. 2M9128B.  
13 Specifically, on or about May 8, 2009, an employee of the Licensee sold or supplied liquor to a  
14 person under the age of twenty-one.

15 5. The Licensee agrees to pay a monetary penalty of three-hundred fifty dollars  
16 (\$350.00) within 30 days of the date of the Final Order of the Board. Payment shall be sent to:

20 6. In the event that the Licensee fails to make full and timely payment of the  
21 monetary penalty as required in Section II, Paragraph 5, the Licensee shall serve a three (3) day  
22 suspension of its liquor license, the dates and time of which shall be set by the Washington  
23 State Liquor Control Board.
