THIS MATTER having come before the Washington State Liquor Control Board (Board) and the Washington State Liquor Control Board Education and Enforcement Division (Enforcement) by and through its attorneys, ROBERT M. MCKENNA, Attorney General and BRIAN J. CONSIDINE, Assistant Attorney General, and FRANCISCO CORONA d/b/a CORONA'S BAR AND GRILL (Licensee) of Union Gap, Washington, through his attorney, SHAWN P. SANT,, and the parties having voluntarily entered into a stipulated settlement agreement for AVN Number 4A9220A, and the Board having considered the stipulated settlement agreement and Enforcement's memorandum recommending acceptance of the stipulated settlement agreement, and the Board having had the opportunity to review the file materials maintained in this case, now therefore:

1 IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that AVN Number 4A9220A for Case Number 23,572 is
2 sustained.

3 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Licensee will have his liquor license suspended
4 for fifteen (15) days. The suspension shall be effective March ⁴ ~~3~~, 2010, at 10 a.m. through
5 March ¹⁹ ~~16~~, 2010, at 10 a.m.

6 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Licensee will pay a two thousand, five hundred
7 dollar (\$2,500) monetary penalty in five (5) installments of: (1) five hundred dollars (\$500) by
8 March 31, 2010; (2) five hundred dollars (\$500) by April 30, 2010; (3) five hundred dollars
9 (\$500) by May 28, 2010; (4) five hundred dollars (\$500) by June 30, 2010; and (5) five
10 hundred dollars (\$500) by July 30, 2010. Payment shall be sent to:

14 In the event the Licensee fails to make full and timely payment of the monetary penalty, the
15 Licensee shall serve an additional fifteen (15) day suspension of its liquor license, the dates

The Washington State Liquor Control Board Education and Enforcement Division (Enforcement) by and through its attorneys, ROBERT M. MCKENNA, Attorney General and BRIAN J. CONSIDINE, Assistant Attorney General, and FRANCISCO CORONA d/b/a CORONA'S BAR AND GRILL (Licensee) of Union Gap, Washington, through his attorney, SHAWN P. SANT, hereby enter into this stipulated settlement agreement for Liquor Control Board.

I. INTRODUCTION

1. The Washington State Liquor Control Board Enforcement Division issued to the Licensee AVN No. 4A9220A, alleging that on or about August 8, 2009, the above-named Licensee, or an employee thereof, (1) allowed a person under twenty-one (21) years of age to enter and remain in an area classified as off-limits to person under the age of twenty one (21), contrary to RCW 66.44.310 and/or WAC 314-11-020(2); and (2) gave, sold and/or supplied

1 liquor to a person(s) under the age of twenty-one (21), contrary to RCW 66.44.270 and/or
2 WAC 314-11-020(1).

3 2. Enforcement and the Licensee wish to enter into a settlement agreement
4 concerning the above-referenced AVNs.

5 **II. AGREEMENT OF THE PARTIES**

6 Prior to the filing of an administrative complaint, Enforcement and the Licensee agree
7 to the following:

8 1. The parties enter into this agreement to avoid the time and expense of further
9 litigation.

10 2. The Licensee explicitly waives the right of further administrative review of all
11 matters related to the above-referenced AVN. Furthermore, the Licensee hereby voluntarily
12 withdraws his request for a hearing in this matter.

13 3. This Agreement constitutes the final written expression of all the terms of this
14 agreement and is a complete and exclusive statement of these terms, and shall be effective
15 when signed by all parties and/or their legal representatives.


16 4. The Licensee admits to only one violation in the above-referenced AVN, that is:
17 on August 8, 2009, the Licensee or an employee thereof, gave, sold and/or supplied liquor to a
18 person(s) under the age of twenty-one (21), contrary to RCW 66.44.270 and/or WAC 314-11-
19 020(1).

20 5. In consideration of and for this settlement agreement, Enforcement agrees to the
21 withdrawal of the additional allegation contained in the AVN. Specifically, Enforcement
22 agrees to withdraw the allegation that the Licensee or an employee thereof, allowed a person
23 under twenty-one (21) years of age to enter and remain in an area classified as off-limits to
24 persons under the age of twenty one (21), contrary to RCW 66.44.310 and WAC 314-11-
25 020(2).


