4 (\$300.00) within thirty days of this order to:



STIPULATED SETTLEMENT
AGREEMENT

The Washington State Liquor Control Board ("WSLCB") Education and Enforcement Division ("Enforcement"), by and through its attorneys, ROBERT M. MCKENNA, Attorney General, and JENNIFER ELIAS, Assistant Attorney General, and PICCADILLY CIRCUS, LLC, d/b/a PICCADILLY CIRCUS PUB AND RESTAURANT (Licensee) of Snohomish, Washington, represented by owner, GEOFFREY WALL, hereby enter into this stipulation and settlement agreement for LCB case number 23,583 (Administrative Violation Notice (AVN) No. 3S9183E).

I. INTRODUCTION

The Washington State Liquor Control Board charged the above-named Licensee in its Complaint dated November 17, 2009, with the following violation of the Washington State Liquor Act:

1 That on or about June 26, 2009, the above-named Licensee, or an employee thereof,
2 sold, gave and/or otherwise supplied liquor to a person under the age of twenty-one (21),
3 contrary to RCW 66.44.270(1).

4 **II. AGREEMENT OF THE PARTIES**

5 Enforcement and the Licensee agree to the following:

6 1. Enforcement and the Licensee enter into this agreement to avoid the time and
7 expense of further litigation.

8 2. The Licensee explicitly waives the right of further administrative review of all
9 matters related to the above-referenced Complaint. Furthermore, the Licensee hereby
10 voluntarily withdraws his request for a hearing in this matter.

11 3. This Agreement constitutes the final written expression of all the terms of this
12 Agreement and is a complete and exclusive statement of these terms.

13 4. The Licensee admits to the violation regarding furnishing alcohol to a minor.
14 Specifically, the Licensee stipulates that on or about June 26, 2009, the Licensee or
15 employee(s) thereof sold, gave and/or otherwise supplied liquor to a person under the age of
16 twenty-one (21), contrary to RCW 66.44.270(1).

17 6. The parties agree that this is the first violation of this type within a two-year
18 period, and as such, the standard penalty is a five (5) day suspension of the liquor license or a
19 \$500 monetary penalty.

20 7. In consideration of and for this settlement agreement, the parties agree that the
21 penalty for the above-referenced violation shall be a \$300 monetary fine or a three (3) day
22 suspension of the Licensee's liquor license.

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2 8. The parties recognize that this settlement agreement is subject to approval by
3 the Washington State Liquor Control Board.


