

The Washington State Liquor Control Board Education and Enforcement Division (Enforcement) represented by its attorneys ROBERT M. MCKENNA, Attorney General, and BRIAN J. CONSIDINE, Assistant Attorney General, and the Licensee, ALI ADWAN d/b/a CIRCLE SEVEN GROCERY (Licensee), hereby enter into this stipulated settlement agreement for Liquor Control Board Case Number 23,594.

I. INTRODUCTION

1. The Washington State Liquor Control Board Education and Enforcement Division issued an Administrative Violation Notice No. 4N9267A (AVN) to the above-named Licensee specifying the following violation of the Washington State Liquor Act:

On or about September 24, 2009, the above-named Licensee, or an employee(s) thereof, sold liquor to a person under the age of twenty-one (21), contrary to RCW 66.44.270 and/or WAC 314-11-020(1).

2. Enforcement and the Licensee wish to enter into a settlement agreement concerning the above-referenced AVN.

STIPULATED SETTLEMENT AGREEMENT

1 **II. AGREEMENT OF THE PARTIES**

2 Prior to the filing of an administrative complaint, Enforcement and the Licensee agree
3 to the following:

4 1. Enforcement and the Licensee enter into this agreement to avoid the time and
5 expense of further litigation.

6 2. The Licensee explicitly waives its right of further administrative review of all
7 matters related to this violation. The Licensee hereby voluntarily withdraws its request for a
8 hearing on this matter.

9 3. The Licensee admits to the violation in the above-referenced AVN.
10 Specifically, on or about September 24, 2009, the above-named Licensee, or an employee(s)
11 thereof, sold liquor to a person under the age of twenty-one (21), contrary to RCW 66.44.270
12 and/or WAC 314-11-020(1).

13 4. The parties agree that the standard penalty for a first violation for selling or
14 supplying liquor to a person apparently under the influence of liquor is a five (5) day
15 suspension of the Licensee's liquor license or a five hundred dollar (\$500) monetary penalty.

16 5. Pursuant to this settlement agreement, the parties agree to an imposition of a
17 three (3) day suspension of the liquor license or a three-hundred dollar (\$300) monetary
18 penalty. The Licensee hereby chooses to pay the monetary penalty of three-hundred dollars
19 (\$300).

20 6. The Licensee shall pay the monetary penalty of three-hundred dollars (\$300) no
21 later than thirty (30) days after the date of the Final Order of the Board. Payment shall be sent



4 State Liquor Control Board.


5 8. The parties recognize that this settlement agreement is subject to approval by


