3 of twenty-one (21) in AVN Number 1K9225A for Case Number 23,595 is sustained.


4 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that within thirty (30) days of this order, the Licensee





STIPULATED SETTLEMENT  
AGREEMENT

The Washington State Liquor Control Board Education and Enforcement Division (Enforcement) represented by its attorneys, ROBERT M. MCKENNA, Attorney General, and BRIAN J. CONSIDINE, Assistant Attorney General, and the Licensee, PACIFIC N.W. CLUBS, INC. d/b/a CLUB ZOO BAR AND GRILL (Licensee) through its representative, DAVID E. ROSS, hereby enter into this stipulated settlement agreement for Liquor Control Board Case Number 23,595.

**I. INTRODUCTION**

1. The Washington State Liquor Control Board Education and Enforcement Division issued an Administrative Violation Notice No. 1K9225A (AVN) on or about September 2, 2009, to the above-named Licensee specifying the following violations of the Washington State Liquor Act:

1 On or about August 13, 2009, the above-named Licensee, or an  
2 employee(s) thereof:

3 (1) Allowed a person under twenty-one (21) years of age to enter and  
4 remain in an area classified as off-limits to persons under the age of twenty-one  
5 (21), contrary to RCW 66.44.310 and WAC 314-11-020(2).

6 (2) Gave, sold and/or supplied liquor to a person(s) under the age of  
7 twenty-one (21), contrary to RCW 66.44.270 and/or WAC 314-11-020(1).

8 2. Enforcement and the Licensee wish to enter into a settlement agreement  
9 concerning the above-referenced AVN.

10 **II. AGREEMENT OF THE PARTIES**

11 Prior to the filing of an administrative complaint, Enforcement and the Licensee agree  
12 to the following:

13 1. Enforcement and the Licensee enter into this agreement to avoid the time and  
14 expense of further litigation.

15 2. The Licensee explicitly waives the right of further administrative review of all  
16 matters related to this violation. The Licensee hereby voluntarily withdraws its request for a  
17 hearing on this matter.

18 3. This Agreement constitutes the final written expression of all the terms of this  
19 agreement and is a complete and exclusive statement of these terms, and shall be effective  
20 when signed by all parties and/or their legal representatives.

21 4. The Licensee admits to only one violation in the above-referenced AVN, that is:  
22 on August 13, 2009, the above-named Licensee, or an employee(s) thereof, allowed a person  
23 under twenty-one (21) years of age to enter and remain in an area classified as off-limits to  
24 persons under the age of twenty one (21), contrary to RCW 66.44.310 and WAC 314-11-  
25 020(2).

1           5.     In consideration of and for this settlement agreement, Enforcement agrees to the  
2 withdrawal of the additional allegation contained in the AVN. Specifically, Enforcement  
3 agrees to withdraw the allegations that the Licensee or an employee thereof, gave, sold and/or  
4 supplied liquor to a person(s) under the age of twenty-one (21), contrary to RCW 66.44.270  
5 and/or WAC 314-11-020(1).

6           6.     The parties agree that the standard penalty for a first violation for allowing a  
7 person under twenty-one (21) years of age to enter and remain in an area classified as off-limits  
8 to persons under the age of twenty one (21) is a five (5) day suspension of its liquor license or  
9 a five-hundred dollar (\$500) monetary penalty.

10          7.     Pursuant to this settlement agreement, the parties agree to an imposition of a  
11 three (3) day suspension of the liquor license or a three-hundred dollar (\$300) monetary  
12 penalty. The Licensee hereby chooses to pay the monetary penalty of three-hundred dollars  
13 (\$300).

14          8.     The Licensee shall pay the monetary penalty of three-hundred dollars (\$300) no  
15 later than thirty (30) days after the date of the Final Order of the Board. Payment shall be sent  
16 to:

19          9.     If the Licensee subsequently fails to make a full and timely payment of the  
20 penalty as required in Section II, Paragraph 7 and 8, then the penalty of a three (3) day  
21 suspension of the Licensee's liquor license shall be imposed.

22          10.    The parties recognize that this settlement agreement is subject to approval by  
23 the Washington State Liquor Control Board.


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1 11. The undersigned parties declare that the terms of this Settlement Agreement are
