STIPULATED SETTLEMENT  
AGREEMENT

The Washington State Liquor Control Board Education and Enforcement Division ("Enforcement") represented by its attorneys ROBERT FERGUSON, Attorney General and Kim O'Neal, Assistant Attorney General and the Licensee, The Hideaway ("Licensee"), represented by William Baumgartner, hereby enter into this stipulated settlement agreement for Liquor Control Board Case Numbers 23,596; 23,654; 23,798; and 23,839.

**I. INTRODUCTION**

The Washington State Liquor Control Board charged the above-named Licensee in Complaints with the following violation of the Washington State Liquor Act:

In case number 23,596, the Board alleged that on October, 2009, the Licensee sold and/or served alcohol to a minor and allowed a minor to frequent the licensed premises in violation of RCW 66.44.310 and 66.44.270.

In case number 23,654, the Board alleged that on February 27, 2010, the Licensee sold and/or served alcohol to a minor and allowed a minor to frequent the licensed premises in violation of RCW 66.44.310 and 66.44.270.

In case number 23,798, the Board alleged that on December 17, 2010, the Licensee sold and/or served alcohol to a minor in violation of RCW 66.44.310.

1 In case number 23,839, the Board alleged that on April 15, 2011, the Licensee sold  
2 and/or served alcohol to a minor and allowed a minor to frequent the licensed premises in  
3 violation of RCW 66.44.310 and 66.44.279.

4 Enforcement and the Licensee wish to enter into a settlement agreement concerning the  
5 above-referenced Complaints.

## 6 II. AGREEMENT OF THE PARTIES

7 Enforcement and the Licensee agree to the following:

8 1. Enforcement and the Licensee enter into this agreement to avoid the time and  
9 expense of further litigation. The Licensee explicitly waives the right of further administrative  
10 review of all matters related to this violation. The Licensee hereby voluntarily withdraws its  
11 requests for a hearing and/or for judicial review on the matters. The Licensee agrees to dismiss  
12 and/or withdraw all pending petitions for judicial review or appeals of any of these cases.

13 2. The parties agree that these violations for sale and/or service to a minor and  
14 permitting a minor to remain on the licensed premises, would result in the penalty of  
15 cancellation of the Licensee's liquor license.

16 4. The parties agree that the Licensee will surrender its liquor license as of June 6,  
17 2014.

18 5. The Licensee agrees that neither it nor any of its principals, owners,  
19 shareholders, financiers, or true parties of interest will ever again apply for or seek to assume,  
20 hold or exercise the privileges of a liquor license in the state of Washington. These parties also  
21 agree that should they or any of them be found to be associated with a liquor license  
22 application in the state of Washington, the appropriate result shall be denial of the license or  
23 application.


24 6. The Board agrees not to seek or impose any other sanction or penalty upon the  
25 Licensee for the four listed Complaints, and it agrees to dismiss these Complaints.




