3 IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the charge in AVN No. 1T9255A for allowing a
4 minor to frequent a restricted area in LCB No. 23,598 is sustained and that the standard penalty
5 of a five (5) day suspension or \$500 monetary penalty is imposed; however, as the licensee has
6 closed the business, the suspension will not be served, but this violation will be considered by the
7 Board in the event the licensee, or any of its officers, applies for a license in the future. The
8 charge of furnishing liquor to a minor in AVN 1T9255A is dismissed.

STIPULATED SETTLEMENT
AGREEMENT

The Washington State Liquor Control Board (LCB) Education and Enforcement Division (Enforcement), by and through its attorneys, ROBERT M. MCKENNA, Attorney General and JENNIFER ELIAS, Assistant Attorney General, and LADY LUCKY, INC., d/b/a MAGGIE O'TOOLE'S PUB & GRUB (Licensee) of Lakewood, Washington, represented by owner, JEFF CORBIN, hereby enter into this stipulation and settlement agreement for LCB case number 23,598 (Administrative Violation Notice (AVN) No. 1T9255A).

I. INTRODUCTION

The Washington State Liquor Control Board, Enforcement and Education Division charged the above-named Licensee, in AVN No. 1T9255A, with the following violations of the Washington State Liquor Act:

ORIGINAL

1 On or about September 12, 2009, the above-named Licensee or employee(s) thereof,
2 allowed a person under twenty-one (21) years of age to remain in an area off-limits to any one
3 under twenty-one years of age, contrary to RCW 66.44.310(1)(a).

4 On or about September 12, 2009, the above-named Licensee or employee(s) thereof,
5 furnished or otherwise supplied liquor to a person under twenty-one (21) years of age, contrary
6 to RCW 66.44.270(1).

7 **II. AGREEMENT OF THE PARTIES**

8 Enforcement and the Licensee agree to the following:

9 1. Enforcement and the Licensee enter into this agreement to avoid the time and
10 expense of further litigation.

11 2. The Licensee explicitly waives the right of further administrative review of all
12 matters related to the above-referenced Complaint. Furthermore, the Licensee hereby
13 voluntarily withdraws his request for a hearing in this matter.

14 3. This Agreement constitutes the final written expression of all the terms of this
15 Agreement and is a complete and exclusive statement of these terms.

16 4. The Licensee admits to the violation regarding allowing a minor to frequent a
17 restricted or off-limits area. Specifically, the Licensee stipulates that on or about September
18 ¹² 21, 2009, the Licensee or employee(s) thereof allowed a person under twenty-one years of age
19 to remain in an area off-limits to any person under twenty-one years of age in violation of
20 RCW 66.44.310(10(a)).

21 5. Enforcement agrees to dismiss the charge of furnishing or otherwise supplying
22 liquor to minor under RCW 66.44.270(1).

23 6. The parties agree that this is the first violation of this type within a two-year
24 period, and as such, the standard penalty is a five (5) day suspension of the liquor license or a
25 \$500 monetary penalty.


26 7. In consideration of and for this settlement agreement, and in acknowledgement

1 that the Licensee is no longer operating the business no penalty shall be imposed for the above
2 violation. The Licensee understands that this violation will become part of his violation
3 history and will be reviewed should the Licensee reapply for a liquor license in the future.

4 8. The parties recognize that this settlement agreement is subject to approval by
5 the Washington State Liquor Control Board.


