

1 It is FURTHER ORDERED that the Licensees shall serve a fifty (50) day suspension of
2 their liquor license, effective December 15, 2010, at 5:00 p.m. through February 3, 2011, at
3 5:00 p.m.

4 It is FURTHER ORDERED that the Licensees shall pay a total monetary penalty of ten
5 thousand dollars (\$10,000.00). The Licensee shall pay the monetary penalty in four (4)
6 separate payments. The first payment of two thousand five hundred dollars (\$2,500.00) shall
7 be made no later than thirty (30) days of entry of the Final Order of the Board. The second
8 payment of two thousand five hundred dollars (\$2,500.00) shall be made no later than sixty
9 (60) days after entry of the Final Order of the Board. The third payment of two thousand five
10 hundred dollars (\$2,500.00) shall be made no later than ninety (90) days after entry of the Final
11 Order of the Board. The fourth and final payment of two thousand five hundred dollars
12 (\$2,500.00) shall be made no later than one hundred twenty (120) days after entry of the Final
13 Order of the Board. Payments shall be sent to:

17 It is FURTHER ORDERED that in the event the Licensees do not fully and timely
18 satisfy the penalties set forth herein, then the standard penalty shall be imposed and the license

STIPULATED SETTLEMENT
AGREEMENT

The Washington State Liquor Control Board (LCB) Education and Enforcement Division (Enforcement), by and through its attorneys, ROBERT M. MCKENNA, Attorney General, and LISA K. ELLEY, Assistant Attorney General, and PRIYANA, INC., d/b/a RENTON 76 of Renton, Washington, by and through its attorney, DAVID MALONE, hereby enter into this Stipulation and Settlement Agreement for LCB case No. 23,613 (AVN No. 2M9278H).

I. INTRODUCTION

In LCB case No. 23,613, the Washington State Liquor Control Board by Complaint dated June 2, 2010, based on AVN No. 2M9278H, alleged that on or about October 5, 2009, the Licensee or employee(s) thereof sold, gave or otherwise supplied liquor to a person(s) under twenty-one (21) years of age, contrary to RCW 66.44.270 and WAC 314-11-020.

1 **II. AGREEMENT OF THE PARTIES**

2 Enforcement and the Licensee agree to the following:

3 1. Enforcement and the Licensee enter into this agreement to avoid the time and
4 expense of further litigation.

5 2. The Licensee explicitly waives the right of further administrative review of all
6 matters related to the above-referenced Complaint. Furthermore, the Licensee hereby
7 voluntarily withdraws its request for a hearing in this matter.

8 3. This Agreement constitutes the final written expression of all the terms of this
9 Agreement and is a complete and exclusive statement of these terms.

10 4. The Licensee admits to the violation set forth in the Complaint. Specifically,
11 the Licensee stipulates that on or about October 5, 2009, an employee of the Licensee sold,
12 gave or otherwise supplied liquor to a person under twenty-one (21) years of age.

13 5. The parties agree that this is the fourth violation of its type within a two (2) year
14 period, and as such, the standard penalty is cancellation of the license.

15 6. In consideration of and for this settlement agreement, the Licensee agrees to
16 serve a fifty (50) day suspension of its liquor license, effective December 15, 2010, at 5:00
17 p.m. through February 3, 2011, at 5:00 p.m. The Licensee further agrees to pay a total
18 monetary penalty of ten thousand dollars (\$10,000.00). The Licensee shall pay the monetary
19 penalty in four (4) separate payments. The first payment of two thousand five hundred dollars
20 (\$2,500.00) shall be made no later than thirty (30) days of entry of the Final Order of the
21 Board. The second payment of two thousand five hundred dollars (\$2,500.00) shall be made
22 no later than sixty (60) days after entry of the Final Order of the Board. The third payment of
23 two thousand five hundred dollars (\$2,500.00) shall be made no later than ninety (90) days
24 after entry of the Final Order of the Board. The fourth and final payment of two thousand five
25 hundred dollars (\$2,500.00) shall be made no later than one hundred twenty (120) days after
26 entry of the Final Order of the Board.

7. The Licensee acknowledges that Enforcement will seek cancellation of Licensee's liquor license should Licensee commit any further public safety violations within the two (2) year time period following entry of the Board's Final Order.

8. The parties recognize that this settlement agreement is subject to approval by the WASHINGTON STATE LIQUOR CONTROL BOARD.






