The Washington State Liquor Control Board (LCB) Education and Enforcement Division (Enforcement) represented by its attorneys, ROBERT M. MCKENNA, Attorney General and GORDON KARG, Assistant Attorney General, and the Licensee, CUTTERCREST L.L.C., d/b/a SPORTS PAGE GRILLE & BAR (Licensee), represented by counsel DAVID OSGOOD, Attorney at Law, hereby enter into this Stipulation and Settlement Agreement for LCB Case No. 23,624.

I. INTRODUCTION

The Washington State Liquor Control Board Enforcement and Education Division charged the above-named Licensee in its Complaint dated April 20, 2010, with the following violation of the Washington State Liquor Rules: that on or about December 30, 2009, the above-named Licensee or employee(s) thereof, was apparently intoxicated on the licensed premise, contrary to WAC 314-11-015(3)(a).

1 Enforcement and the Licensee wish to enter into a settlement agreement concerning the
2 above-referenced Complaint.

3 II. AGREEMENT OF THE PARTIES

4 Enforcement and the Licensee agree to the following:

5 1. Enforcement and the Licensee enter into this agreement to avoid the time and
6 expense of further litigation. The Licensee explicitly waives the right of further administrative
7 review of all matters related to this violation. The Licensee hereby voluntarily withdraws its
8 request for a hearing on the matter.

9 2. The Licensee disputes the truth of the allegations contained in the April 20,
10 2010, Complaint. However, in order to take advantage of Enforcement's offer of settlement, to
11 avoid legal expenses attendant with further proceedings, and in recognition of the fact that if
12 this matter were to proceed to a hearing, there is a risk to the Licensee that an administrative
13 proceeding would result in the conclusion that on or about December 30, 2009, the above-
14 named Licensee or employee(s) thereof, was apparently intoxicated on the licensed premise,
15 contrary to WAC 314-11-015(3)(a), and therefore accepts this Stipulated Settlement
16 Agreement.

17 3. Based on this Settlement Agreement, the parties agree that the Washington State
18 Liquor Control Board will consider that the violation set forth in the April 20, 2010, Complaint
19 as specified in Section II, Paragraph 2, has been sustained.

20 4. Pursuant to this settlement, the parties agree to imposition of a monetary penalty
21 of three hundred dollars (\$300.00), which shall be paid by the Licensee no later than thirty (30)
22 days after the date of the Final Order of the Board. Payment shall be sent to:


1 5. In the event that the Licensee does not make full and timely payment of the
2 monetary penalty as required in Section II, Paragraph 4, then the Licensee shall serve a five (5)
3 day suspension of its liquor license, the dates and time of which shall be set by the Washington
4 State Liquor Control Board.


5 6. The parties recognize that this Settlement Agreement is subject to approval by


