
1 referenced violation. The Permit holder shall pay the monetary penalty within thirty (30) days

The Washington State Liquor Control Board Education and Enforcement Division (Enforcement) represented by its attorneys ROBERT M. MCKENNA, Attorney General and TIMOTHY D. FORD, Assistant Attorney General and the Licensee, ZAKK 4 INC. d/b/a 7-ELEVEN STORE 2307-14476 E (Licensee) represented by Khalid Hussain, Owner/Manager, hereby enter into this stipulated settlement agreement for Liquor Control Board Case No. 23,625.

I. INTRODUCTION

The Washington State Liquor Control Board, Enforcement and Education Division charged the above-named Licensee, in Administrative Violation Notice (AVN) No. 2M9358B, with the following alleged violation of the Washington State Liquor Control Board rules and regulations:

1 That on or about December 24, 2009, the above-named Licensee, or employee(s)
2 thereof, sold, gave or otherwise supplied liquor to a person(s) under twenty-one (21) years of
3 age, in violation of RCW 66.44.270(1) and WAC 314-11-020(1).

4 Enforcement and the Licensee wish to enter into a settlement agreement concerning the
5 above-referenced AVN.

6 II. AGREEMENT OF THE PARTIES

7 Enforcement and the Licensee agree to the following:

8 1. Enforcement and the Licensee enter into this agreement to avoid the time and
9 expense of further litigation. The Licensee explicitly waives the right of further administrative
10 review of all matters related to the above-referenced violation and AVN. The Licensee hereby
11 voluntarily withdraws its requests for a hearing in this matter.

12 2. This agreement constitutes the final written expression of all the terms of this
13 agreement and is a complete and exclusive statement of these terms.

14 3. The Licensee admits the violation set forth above and referenced in the
15 complaint: that on or about December 24, 2009, the above-named Licensee, or employee(s)
16 thereof, sold, gave or otherwise supplied liquor to a person(s) under twenty-one (21) years of
17 age, in violation of RCW 66.44.270(1) and WAC 314-11-020(1). It is their position that if any
18 of its former employees committed the alleged violation; it would have been in violation of
19 Zakk 4 Inc. directives to staff, company policy, and liquor enforcement training.

20 4. The Licensee acknowledges this is the Licensee's first violation of this type
21 within a twenty-four month period, which carries a standard monetary penalty of five hundred
22 dollars (\$500) or a five day suspension of the liquor license.

23 5. The Licensee agrees to pay a total monetary penalty of three hundred dollars
24 (\$300) for the above-referenced violation. This amount shall be paid within thirty (30) days of
25 the date of the final order of the Washington State Liquor Control Board. Payment shall be
26

1 made to the Washington State Liquor Control Board no later than 4:00 p.m. on the applicable
2 date.

3 6. In the event that the Licensee does not make a timely payment, as required by
4 Section II, ¶7, the Licensee shall serve a five (5) day suspension of its liquor license, pursuant
5 to WAC 314-29-020; the dates and times of which shall be set by the Washington State Liquor
6 Control Board.

7 7. The undersigned parties declare that the terms of this Settlement Agreement are
8 completely read, wholly understood, and voluntarily accepted for the purpose of making a full
9 and final compromise and settlement of any and all claims arising from the above referenced
10 Complaint.

11 8. The parties recognize that this settlement agreement is subject to approval by
12 the Washington State Liquor Control Board.


